LITTLE MALOP STREET PRECINCT

This city by the bay is perfect to explore by foot. Little Malop Street is a high-energy pedestrian precinct with bars, great coffee, street art and restaurants which each put a special spin on cuisines from around the world. The fun spills onto the street and wends its way down secret alleyways, where you'll make surprise finds such as high-end French fare, a speakeasy bar and dumplings with fun flavours like moussaka or butter chicken. Enjoy live music, catch a show at the flamboyant arts centre or muse over an art exhibition in this UNESCO City of Design.

THE WATERFRONT

Geelong's waterfront is a sparkling bay with bobbing yachts and a grassy foreshore lined with palm trees. Many of the precinct's cafés and restaurants have water views. Admire the historic carousel and the artfully painted bollards, each playfully representing a character from Geelong's history. Wander through the **Botanic Gardens** and along Cunningham Pier and Eastern Beach where you can swim in art deco sea baths. Take your adventure to new heights by sipping on a cocktail at a rooftop bar, riding the **Giant Sky Wheel**, or by enjoying a helicopter joy ride over the bay.



PAKO

To the west, trendy Pakington Street has outstanding restaurants, bars, cafés, retail and art. Cosmopolitan at the northern end and a bit fancier further south, the vibrant eateries serve-up everything from Asian-fusion to top cuts of steak and hearty Italian faves.

**OVER THE RIVER**

The Barwon River divides Newtown and Belmont, where 20km of leafy paths and further dining experiences await. In the thriving hub of Belmont you'll find coffee, shops, award-winning beers at **Mt Pleasant Rd Brewers** and **Archive Wine Bar** where the platters are as good as the drops.

FEDERAL MILLS PRECINCT

Federal Mills in North Geelong is a grand old woollen mill which has been impeccably transformed into a foodie and history-lover's dream. The original industrial features of the red brick buildings have been restored and now house a bakery, restaurant, gin and vodka distillery, vintage market and collectables gallery.

Come for a Crème Brûlée donut at **The Paddock**, sip on **Anther Spirits**' artisanal gin and feast on Mediterranean fare at **1915 Restaurant** before checking out the stunning silo art featuring native Australian blooms.

FYANSFORD PAPER MILL PRECINCT

What started in 1878 as a paper mill overlooking Buckley Falls is now a beautiful archipelago of stone buildings housing **Provenance Wines** – a James Halliday 5-star winery – shops and artist studios. It's hard to believe this piece of picturesque countryside is only minutes from the city. Book a tour with **Fyansford Paper Mill Heritage Tours** to learn more about the oldest remaining paper mill in Australia and to discover areas not open to the public.

MOORABOOL VALLEY

MOORABOOL VALLEY

The Moorabool Valley is Australia's secret wine region – a quiet achiever producing some of the country's finest drops, in a bucolic landscape. A river runs through the dramatic countryside which is peppered with family-run cellar doors and restaurants.

Low-yielding rocky limestone and basalt soils produce grapes full of character. Sip on James Halliday 5-star rated wines precisely paired with locally-grown produce; you'll even discover handmade chocolates and the freshest goods at the **Golden Plains Farmers' Market** held on the first Saturday of each month (except January) in Bannockburn.

MARVELOUS MEREDITH

Located almost halfway between Geelong and Ballarat, Meredith boasts a welcoming village-style atmosphere. The rural town is known across the country for its festivals and the much-loved Meredith Dairy goats' cheese which you can try in town at their farm store café. Twice a year music lovers flock to Meredith's rolling hills to enjoy **Meredith Music Festival** and **Golden Plains Music Festival** at The Supernatural Amphitheatre. Be sure to take a look around this rural slice of paradise, which has two pubs, a café, servo and general store. Drive a further 11 minutes and you'll find yourself at the natural beauty that is the **Brisbane Ranges National Park**.

YOU YANGS & SURROUNDS



You Yangs (Wurdi Youang)

YOU YANGS REGIONAL PARK

Bubbling spectacularly from the Western Plains are the huge granite slabs and boulders of the You Yangs – a playground for natural adventure in the Australian wilderness. They're drizzled with trails, keeping everyone from hikers to mountain bikers, rock climbers and picnickers happy (dogs on leads are welcome too). This significant Wadawurrung land, known as Wurdi Youang, holds hundreds of cultural sites including a water well on Big Rock. Keep an eye out for Bunjil, a huge rock formation artwork of the Wadawurrung creator spirit (wedge-tailed eagle).

SERENDIP SANCTUARY

Nearby, Serendip Sanctuary's 250 peaceful hectares of woods and wetland are perfect for observing wildlife and birds. A new sensory garden is coming to life at this site, with five distinct spaces designed to engage each of the senses. It's a natural oasis within easy reach of Melbourne.

PORTARLINGTON, ST LEONARDS & DRYSDALE



📍 Foreshore Trail

Mellow little towns hugging the north shore of The Bellarine revel in their sheltered bay beaches, long coastal pathways and water-view wineries.

Portarlington Beach is a favourite with swimmers while St Leonards Pier and Indented Head are top spots for snorkelling. Walk or ride the 17km Foreshore Trail between them, or take on the 35km Bellarine Rail Trail, stretching to Geelong. In Indented Head you can explore the wreck of the 1925 paddle steamer Ozone.

Boutique wineries pair cool climate maritime drops with fine regional produce and some overlook the twinkling blue Port Phillip Bay. Take a mussel tour from Portarlington, where you can pluck your own from the bay, then sit back while a chef cooks them up for you on board.

For a few hours of the high life, enjoy a gastronomic dining experience aboard a moving historic train with **The Q Train**. Picnics can also be curated (think smoked fish, fresh sourdough, and hand-made butter) and enjoyed at one of the many beaches, or at The Dell, a grassy coastal park tucked into the seaside cliffs at Clifton Springs.




These pretty coastal towns 'hold hands' across the Barwon River and are home to some of the best beaches in Australia. The area's geography has created idyllic options for families and surfers.

The Barwon River has sandy flats and sheltered waters while Ocean Grove's Main Beach offers more froth and invigorating ocean breezes; surfers embrace the wilder 13th Beach in Barwon Heads.

Wander Hitchcock Avenue in Barwon Heads for boutique shopping and dining, or hike around the Bluff for sea views and a peek at one of Australia's premiere golf courses. The Bellarine is home to some of the best-ranked public courses in the country and Barwon Heads was crowned Australia's Best Golf Town in 2025. End your explorations with the day's catch at an over-water restaurant.

At the Heads

In Ocean Grove the food offering is much like the town itself: relaxed and nostalgic. On The Terrace, there are takeaway options to bring back to the beach or cafés that serve all-day breakfast no matter what time you roll out of bed.

If you can't get enough of the coastline, head to **The Dunes** overlooking the main beach. Here, you'll find share-style platters with Mediterranean flare, pizzas and cocktails to wash it all down.

While the beach draws visitors to the area, there's a plethora of things to see and do away from the water. Take a nature walk through the Ocean Grove Nature Reserve or head to the outskirts for incredible wine or top golf.

QUEENSCLIFF & POINT LONSDALE

In Victorian times, holiday-makers flocked to Queenscliff, dining in grand buildings and staying in opulent triple-storeyed hotels.


The heritage architecture has been meticulously preserved and the town's old world charm is striking. The wide main street is dotted with art galleries, antique treasure troves, boutique shops and cafés.

This maritime haven has a picturesque harbour where you can set-off for a day of diving, fishing or even swimming with marine life with **Sea All Dolphin Swims** and the 42-metre observation tower provides panoramic views.


Learn all about the seafaring history at the **Queenscliffe Maritime Museum** where you can also try your hand at a pirate-themed escape room.

Point Lonsdale Lighthouse and Pier

Board a steam train on the **Bellarine Railway** for a scenic ride with the family or leave the kids at home and book in for **The Blues Train** – an iconic blues concert across four carriages. **Searoad Ferries** cruise to and from the Mornington Peninsula – the ferry terminal is an architectural masterpiece and inside you'll find one of The Bellarine's best restaurants.

For generations, Point Lonsdale has been a favourite coastal escape for families. Its main strip is a pretty village with cafés and shops sitting directly opposite the beach.

The intimate and low-key vibe is perfect for wellness getaways with serene soaks, a beachside sauna and massages at a day spa, but if you're looking for thrills, head to Rip View Lookout, near **Point Lonsdale Lighthouse**, and watch the turbulent water race through the heads. Surfers love Point Lonsdale Back Beach while the Front Beach is more protected.

ON THE COAST

One of The Bellarine's most scenic walks is the **Barwon Bluff Trail**, passing local icons – the bridge, **At The Heads** restaurant and The Bluff – with a mix of steps, gravel and sand. Be sure to keep an eye out for migrating whales along the way (Jun-Aug is peak). In Queenscliff, trails range from the accessible **Ferry to Pier walk** (500m) to the **3.2km Lovers Walk** through coastal Moonah Woodland. For something a little more challenging, the **Bellarine Coastal Trail** stretches 17km from Portarlington to St Leonards along mostly flat gravel paths, traversing a variety of coastal landscapes along the way.

IN THE COUNTRY OR IN THE BUSH

Brisbane Ranges National Park is home to Victoria's richest wildflower habitat, with walking trails ranging from short strolls to multi-day hikes. Choose from the **Ted Errey Nature Circuit** (8km), **Anakie Gorge Walk** (3.5km), or **Wadawurrung Walk** (2.5km). For serious hikers, the 40km **Burchell Trail** takes three days with campsites along the way.

Closer to Melbourne, the **You Yangs Regional Park** features distinctive granite peaks that rise abruptly from the flat plains below. Scenic walks include the **Flinders Peak climb** (450 steps, 200m elevation, 45–60 minutes return), **East-West Walk** (4.5km), **Big Rock Walk** (3km), and **Branding Yard Trail** (5km). Dogs are welcome on lead.



The **Barwon River Trail** is a calm place to meander – much loved by locals on foot and on bike. Ride the 20km along the Barwon River (the cascading Buckley Falls are a highlight) and make a pitstop at one of the many parklands, playgrounds, picnic areas and nature reserves along the way. Or hit the **Bellarine Rail Trail** which stretches 35km from South Geelong to Queenscliff with coastal, countryside scenery and, if you're lucky, a heritage train.





WALKS & TRAILS


AVERAGE TEMPERATURES
