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BASS COAST Villages

Take a country drive through slow-living, leg-stretching, food-loving villages along Gippsland's Bass Coast.

Soak up the views as you meander through velvety dairy country to peaceful bayside walking trails, on to dramatic cliffs and wild, windswept beaches. It's a choose-your-own-adventure day out that'll have you skipping along from coffee to cheesery, walking tracks and wildlife cuddles, then back for wineries and warming pub lunches. Here's a round up of the top things to eat, drink and do in the villages of the Bass Coast.

KILCUNDA

- 1 **Kilcunda Ocean View Hotel**
Bistro meals with a side of ocean views, live music and incredible sunsets.
- 2 **Kilcunda General Store**
Seaside café, tasty healthy meals and coffee.
- 3 **Udder & Hoe**
Abundant local produce store, cafe and deli.
- 4 **George Bass Coastal Walk**
A dramatic cliff top walk, with sweeping ocean views.
San Remo - Kilcunda | 7km/ 2 hours one-way
- 5 **Bass Coast Rail Trail**
Victoria's only coastal rail trail, across the spectacular Kilcunda Trestle Bridge. Anderson - Wonthaggi | 16km one way

- 6 **Macca's Farm**
Fresh farm grown produce, on-site café complete with free range pigs and chickens.
- 7 **Bassine Specialty Cheese**
On farm café and store. Handmade artisan farmhouse cheese and fresh non-homogenised, pasteurised milk.
- 8 **Bass River Winery**
Enjoy premium single estate wines at the cellar door of this proud family-run winery.

KERNOT

- 9 **Kernot Food & Wine Store**
Country food and wine store. Wood fired pizzas, great live music and local wine.

DALYSTON

- 10 **Old Dalyston Church Café**
A beautiful historic church restored into a licensed restaurant.

CAPE PATERSON

- 11 **Goshen Country Farm Gate**
Organic vegetable farm and green grocer selling produce from the farm gate.
- 12 **Cape Tavern**
A bistro and bar in the heart of Cape Paterson, just moments from the beach.
- 13 **Cape Paterson Foreshore Track**
Scenic clifftop lookouts and iconic rock pools.

CORINELLA

- 14 **Fig & the Bay**
Residing in the Hughes Heritage Home. Enjoy a coffee under the majestic fig trees.
- 15 **Settlement Point Walk**
A short walk through natives and wetlands to views of Western Port's cliffs and coastline, and nearby French Island. (850m)
- 16 **Corinella Foreshore Walk**
Enjoy views of French Island and Western Port Bay. (2.3km return)

THE GURDIES

- 17 **The Gurdies Winery**
A comfy, rustic meeting place to relax, take in magnificent views and enjoy delicious wines.
- 18 **The Gurdies Nature Conservation Reserve**
260 hectares of reserve with multiple walking tracks.

GRANTVILLE

- 19 **Maru Koala & Animal Park**
For big and little kids, pat a koala, hand feed kangaroos and wallabies.
- 20 **Grantville Foreshore Walk**
A short walk (720m return) with views of Western Port, French Island and Western Port's mangrove habitats.
