

ARE YOU A HOLIDAYMAKER THAT LIVES FOR A PACKED ITINERARY? A DAY THAT'S STACKED WITH ACTIVITIES FROM 7AM-7PM, WITH NO TIME FOR DOWNTIME? AVERT YOUR EYES NOW — THIS ONE IS DEFINITELY NOT FOR YOU.

Or maybe it is. Maybe it's a sign that you need to swap rushed trips for slow travel, where the best itinerary is no itinerary, and stays are all about what happens when you make no plans.

But don't mistake slow for boring. The Mudgee Region punches above its weight for pubs, restaurants, cellar doors, boutiques and experiences — there's just no rush to see them all in one weekend. That's exactly what a Mudgee Monday is for...



Stay Slow

The Mudgee Region just knows how to do slow — and it all starts with your accommodation. This is not about finding a stay to simply rest your head — it's about finding a spot that allows you to truly relax, switch off and SLOW. DOWN. A stay that is an experience, not just a bed. One that encourages you to put on your OOO and just be. Catch your breath at **Peppertree Farm**, an award-winning luxury farmstay with several accommodation options, from quaint cottages to panoramic views and log fires. Or opt for **Evanslea**, known for its in-room massages (yes please!), riverside frontage perfect for throwing in a line and peaceful country gardens.

And if you're ready to truly unplug (no TV, no WiFi, can you do it!), head to **Evamor Valley** — an award-winning luxury glamping spot, located just minutes from the CBD. Their lush king beds, private hot tubs and plush robes are just made for lazy afternoons, enjoying doing, well, very little. Here, you'll find yourself spending the evening taking in the jaw-dropping sunset, staring up at the stars and relaxing by the fire pit — without your phone in-hand.

Wine & Dine Slow

This is not a place for wine sculling. Here, we sip our wine, savouring every last drop, pairing it with local produce, and sharing it with good friends — before we order another glass and repeat.

The same goes for meals. There's no rushing here. No hurried lunches, no quick dinners, no food in front of the TV (heaven forbid!) We're all about taking the time to enjoy a meal — whether it's family-friendly pub-style food at **Club Mudgee**, the **Woolpack Hotel**, or **Mudgee Brewing Co**, breakfast in **Alby + Esthers'** vine-covered courtyard, or a date night at **Gigi's Restaurant** — we treat every meal

like an occasion; a chance to taste the best of the region's fare.

Mudgee Region's cellar doors have been doing the "wine slow" trend before it was cool, taking the time to chat to customers and share the joy of winemaking. And drinking. Cellar doors like **791 Estate** (ask for Fiona the Owner!) **Logan Wines**, **Lowe Family Wine Co** and **Clover Cellars** are firm believers in talking you through their range, making a tasting seem like a catch-up with old friends. There's no rush to try every bottle in 30 minutes — savour each drop, swirl every glass and sip your favourites.

Looking to pick up a few local treats? Head to **10's Estate Orchard**, where organically grown produce comes straight from the cherry and fig trees — and yes, there might even be cherry ice-cream in the freezer.

Then drop into **Old Wheels Grind** for THE BEST freshly cooked cinnamon donuts paired with a great coffee, served from a vintage Land Rover in a paddock just outside Mudgee. Pull up a seat by the crackling fire pit, grab a picnic rug and stretch out for a while. No rush, no plans.



Grab your paddle and get on the water with **Southern Cross Kayaking**; their guided kayak tours are the best way to not only see the region’s stunning escarpment, but to force you to be present, mindful and adapt to nature’s much gentler pace.

GULGONG — A SLICE OF HISTORY WITH A BIG DOSE OF PERSONALITY.

Step into a town where history isn't hidden in museums but written into every crooked street and character-filled building. Born in the Gold Rush, Gulgong's narrow laneways set it apart from the wide streets of other country towns — making wandering here feel like stepping onto the set of a period film (which, fun fact, has actually happened).

Gulgong wears its past with pride. Many still remember it as the 'Ten Dollar Town,' made famous on Australia's old \$10 note, and the stories continue to come to life as you stroll the streets and museums. Step into the UNESCO-listed Holtermann Collection of photographs and see pioneering Australia captured through a lens. Feel the poetry of Henry Lawson woven into the landscape around you, and if you listen closely, you might just hear the lingering echoes of Dame Nellie Melba's encore in the oldest operating opera house in the Southern Hemisphere, right in the heart of Mayne Street.

Symbols carved into the streets hint at a secret travellers' language from another era, waiting for modern-day visitors to decode. And the town's boutiques, eclectic stores and rustic pubs turn shopping (and pub-hopping) into a treasure hunt all on its own.

But what really sets Gulgong apart is its community. Locals chat on the street, waves and smiles are exchanged freely, and the town's big heart is always on display. Jump in, have a chat, and soak up the warm welcome.




Rylstone slows you down in the best way — tree-lined streets, heritage cottages and a laid-back pace that feels instantly restorative. Here, the slow life is celebrated in cuisine, artistry and locally made treasures.

Meandering from one end of town to the other is almost meditative. The town's picturesque charm is a haven for the many artists and creatives who call Rylstone home. There is plenty to uncover within the town's cottage shops, galleries and cafes — from stylish decor and handcrafted wares, to treats for knitters and vintage music lovers.

Foodies will feel right at home here. From soulful cafés and friendly pubs, to some of the region's finest wines and produce, Rylstone is all about savouring the moment. Each November, the Rylstone Street Feast takes over the main street with long tables, gourmet flavours, live music and bustling stalls. It's a feast worth marking in your calendar.

Rylstone still feels like a small farming village. Weekends mean community markets and showground activities, shopfronts alive with friendly local chatter. It's easy to explore at your own pace and just as easy to stay a while over lunch or a coffee.

For those drawn to nature, Rylstone is a gateway to enchanting trails and waterways. Ferntree Gully, Ganguddy-Dunns Swamp and Wollemi National Park all take centre stage here. Rare and endangered plants and wildlife abound, including the prehistoric Wollemi Pine — but its exact location is a closely guarded secret.



Kandos

AN URBAN LANDSCAPE ALIVE WITH ARTS, CULTURE AND A RICH INDUSTRIAL PAST.



ART, HISTORY, CULTURE OR SMALL-TOWN QUIRK — KANDOS HAS IT ALL.

Set against the bold backdrop of the aptly-named ‘Rocky’ and ‘Baldy’ in the Coomber Melon mountain range, Kandos is a small town with a big story. A community cemented (literally) in industrial history, now reinventing itself through creativity and culture.

Once proudly ‘the town that built Sydney,’ Kandos rolled with the changes when the cement works closed in 2011. Today, the biennial CEMENTA festival anchors Kandos’ transformation — a celebration of contemporary art that fills the town with curiosity, conversation and just the right dose of creative mischief. From almost anywhere in town, you can still glimpse the abandoned cement works, standing as a reminder that big stories sometimes come in concrete form.

Step back in time at the Kandos Museum, where industrial machinery, memorabilia and tales of hard yakka tell the story of a town shaped by the 20th century. Then stroll down Kandos’ main street, Angus Avenue, where you’ll find quirky cafés, galleries and crafts (almost certainly stitched, painted or knitted with love by local nans). Thrill-seekers in thrift will be in heaven, with multiple op shops hiding unexpected treasures.

Kandos knows how to put on a good show and embraces all walks of life. CEMENTA returns this October — your invite to join the town in full weird-and-wonderful self-expression. Or, if V8 muscle is calling, start working on that mullet now for the Kandos Street Machine next summer.

Kandos is a place of deep cultural connection on Wiradjuri country. Explore spaces for learning and healing through indigenous art, storytelling, workshops and guided experiences. Visit Ganguddy, the traditional land of the Dabee people, to share an experience of connection to country that will stay with you long after you leave.

GET ARTY

Join in the creative fun of Kandos’ contemporary art scene at a local gallery.

THRIFT OF THE SEASON

Bag up plenty of gems and knick-knacks with Kandos’ boutiques and op-shops.

ROAD TRIP

Surrounded by rocky hills, bushland and countryside. A road trip to or from Kandos is a must to take in its autumn landscape.

Hit the open road, take the scenic route and give yourself time to explore. The Mudgee Region isn't just one place— it's a collection of small towns and villages, each with its own character and charm. Step beyond the featured towns and you'll find quiet corners perfect for a breather, spots full of local colour, and places where the welcomes are warm. Whether it's fresh air and solitude or good times with the locals, every stop has something worth discovering.

CAPERTEE VALLEY

Australia's own "Grand Canyon". Second only in size to the world's grandest, but actually wider, this World Heritage-listed valley is all towering escarpments and wide-open skies. Stop at Pearson's Lookout for that hit of awe. Adventurers can hike, ride, birdwatch or even take to the skies by helicopter. Slow it down with camping under a blanket of stars, or retreat to one of the valley's stays surrounded by nature. The town of Capertee makes a handy pit stop — top up on food and fuel and keep an ear out for the call of the endangered Regent Honeyeater.

LUE

A village full of surprises: a pub, a historic train track, pottery, farm stays, olive oils and motocross tracks. Keep your eyes peeled — koalas have been known to sleep in the local treetops.

HARGRAVES

Hargraves is often referred to as the 'veteran' of the region's gold towns. Pop into the old general store to stock up on supplies and soak in a slice of village life. The surrounding countryside is dotted with fossicking hot spots, so grab some gear and try your luck in the creeks and gullies.



Towns & Villages

WINDEYER

This village wears its gold rush history proudly, with reminders scattered through the landscape. The iconic local pub is the heart of the community — swing by for a hearty feed, a cold beer and a yarn with a local. Camping grounds and farm stays make it easy to linger longer, while fossicking opportunities abound for those who want to strike it rich.

ULAN

A good chance for coal truck or train spotting. Though, local knowledge says that if you slip some cash over the bar at the Ulan Pub the beef jerky handed back in a ziplocked bag is well worth the stop. Beyond town, stretch your legs along The Drip Walking Track — when the weather is warm the creek entices you off the main track — and don't miss Hands on Rock, where ancient Aboriginal art tells stories older than time.

SOFALA

A historic gold town, tucked alongside the Turon River, Sofala's hills were once dotted with countless gold rush camps. It's heritage main street still stands like a snapshot from the past — the historic town has actually transformed into an authentic set for several Australian films! A few free camping spots along the river make it ideal to linger a little longer.

BYLONG VALLEY

A pastoral valley of rolling green hills and river bends — perfect for a scenic drive with through the countryside. This sleepy valley rewards you with some of the region's most beautiful scenery. Once famous (or infamous) in the region for its mouse races — ask a local if you're curious!

COOYAL

Cooyal's lively pub is a classic country stop for a cold one, hearty meals and a bit of local entertainment.

WOLLAR

Just down the road, Wollar marks the gateway to Goulburn River National Park. Pitch a tent at Big River or Spring Gully campgrounds or chase the breeze to the top of Castle Rock in Munghorn Gap Nature Reserve for views that make you feel on top of the world.

HILL END

Step back in time and wander through a town that once pulsed with gold rush fever. In the late 1800s, Hill End boasted twenty-eight pubs and more than 8,000 people. Today, heritage buildings highlight it's rich history. Explore an old mining tunnel, or try your own luck fossicking with locals. In the 1940's, Hill End was rediscovered by artists and quickly became a thriving artists' colony. It is still a beloved destination of artists today. Arrive via the scenic loop through Mudgee and Sofala, or for off-road adventure, tackle The Bridle Track from Bathurst.



The kids have had enough screen time – and honey, so have you. You’ve just binged all six seasons of *Selling Sunset*; seriously, it’s enough.

We all need to get outside, breathe in fresh country air and feel the grass between our toes. Somewhere the kids can be kids – running under sprinklers, riding bikes for days, roasting marshmallows under the stars.

And if there’s a bar for the adults? Even better.

Enter a much-needed escape to the Mudgee Region – where the wine is chilled, the sunsets are stellar and there’s plenty of space for the kids to roam, play and explore.

Start your visit at **Clover Cellars**, just a stone’s throw from the CBD. The kids can cut loose while adults taste their way through the Hop & Clover range of locally brewed beers. Giant chess, footballs, and a lake to fish in make it a child’s paradise, with occasional family-friendly races (like hobby horse challenges) and even a kids’ rave (yes, really!). Drop in for a ploughman’s lunch, check for visiting food trucks over the weekend, and enjoy live music that adds to the relaxed, fun vibe. Fresh fruit soda for the little ones, gin for the grown-ups.

A little further up the road, you can expect to be treated like family at **791 Estate** – Fiona the owner and Brendan the winemaker will instantly make you feel like you’re at home, washing up aside. This is a small-batch winery with a café-style menu (plan your visit over lunch and don’t miss the monthly pizza and wine nights!) and a vibe that’s a glimpse of country living. There are chickens wandering the grounds, a firepit ready for the cooler evenings



and enough space for a game of cricket. It’s just like you’re chilling in Fiona’s backyard – because you are.

When you’re ready for more adventure, take the drive out to Ganguddy–Dunn’s Swamp, near Rylstone. This serene waterway is surrounded by bushland. Yes, there are easy bushwalking tracks, but the ultimate experience is by kayak. Hire a kayak from **Southern Cross Kayaking** or join a guided tour and paddle out to explore the waterways, cliffs and caves that can’t be reached on foot. And when you’ve had enough? Pitch a tent for the night under the starlit sky (ahhhh, bliss).

Prefer your nature with a side of comfort? **Peppertree Farm** has accommodation across 250 acres of farmland. The woolshed has been converted into luxurious accommodation, while the homestead has room for a few families; every cottage combines modern luxury with rustic charm for a quintessential rural stay. Quiet and comfortable, with heaps of space for the family to explore, it’s farm life without the pre-dawn milking, but with room to move, peace and quiet, and views of the Mudgee hills.

Dinner awaits at **Club Mudgee**, the family-friendly hotspot in the centre of town. Let the kids climb the outdoor playground while you hit the Sports Bar. Hot tip: try the lychee martini; you won’t regret it! And if you’re more of

a craft beer type, Club Mudgee has an impressive range. You can’t go wrong at the bistro either – the roast is great, the Rogan Josh is a delight and the chicken schnitzel is...Now that I think about it, I might just head there for a schnitty tonight. PSA: kids eat free on Sundays, so plan your visit accordingly.

Before heading home, visit **10’s Estate** and sample produce from their organic orchard. In December cherries are ripe for picking, so grab a hat and bucket and pick straight from the trees. Outside cherry season, enjoy their cherry and fig produce, along with a drop of 10’s Estate wine.

And if the kids still have energy to burn (or you secretly do too), head over to the Mudgee Pump Track and Glen Willow’s Multi-Sport Court. Bring a bike, scooter, ball, or even just your competitive spirit, and let the family go wild – ramps, hoops, goals and more, all set in the great outdoors. Who knew exercise could be this fun?

Remember what it was like being a kid on holidays?

No phones, no work on Monday morning, no responsibilities – just climbing trees, running through the long grass, cherry juice dribbling down your chin as you spit the seeds out on the ground. Sigh.

The good news? It’s still here waiting for you in Mudgee...

Don't get us wrong — we're all for a digital detox and some time in the real world.

But some memories are worth grabbing the camera for.

And around the Mudgee Region, there's more than a few spots that just scream 'post me on Instagram'.

From our iconic backdrops to those lesser-known spots that deserve a moment in the spotlight, here's our go-to guide to the most Instagrammable spots across the Mudgee Region...

THE CLOCK TOWER: The Mudgee Clock Tower, at the corner of Church and Market streets, is a heavy hitter when it comes to photogenic scenes in town. Surrounded by floral garden beds and flanked on neighbouring street corners by stunning churches, leafy trees and heritage buildings, it's the perfect place to capture the essence of Mudgee. PS It's also the iconic clock tower from beloved Channel 9 series Doctor Doctor, so definitely worth a snap.

Where to take your shot: The St John's Anglican Church corner, in front of the Clock Tower, with St Mary's stunning steeple behind it.

THE DRIP: A short but beautifully scenic walk along the Goulburn River in the National Park and you'll find yourself at The Drip — a towering wall of dripping water that flows down into the bush below. The river carves a path through the oversized rocks, making it both an aesthetically pleasing walk and the ideal place for a cheeky dip. Keep your clothes on please.

Where to take your shot: At the very end of The Drip's walking trail, nestled beneath the majestic rock wall, staring down the river.

REGENT THEATRE: A relic of Mudgee's iconic heritage buildings, the Regent Theatre is an art deco lover's wet dream. Featuring a four-storey facade, classic lines, illuminated cinema billboard and detailed tile work, it's one of the most recognised buildings in the Mudgee Region. And with two locals recently snapping up this historic building, grab your pics now before this heritage gem gets a makeover.

Where to take your shot: Opposite the theatre in all its glory, preferably early morning when there's no cars blocking your view.

GANGUDDY-DUNNS SWAMP: Love nature, sun and sheer serenity? Then this Kodak moment will bring you more than just a good photo. A stunning scene of winding river valleys, towering pagoda rock formations, diverse plant life and Aboriginal heritage — it's definitely worth the drive.

Where to take your shot: Hop in a kayak with Southern Cross Kayaking and paddle your way into the waterway for jaw-dropping snaps among the blissful surrounds. Waterproof case for iPhone highly recommended.

ALBY & ESTHERS: Tucked down a cobblestoned alleyway, Alby & Esthers is a picture-perfect café. Housed in a circa-1873 stone terrace, it's full of character, friendly staff, and a menu inspired by the best local produce. Autumn is the perfect time to visit — the grapevine-shaded courtyard turns golden and cosy, or you can snuggle inside if it's a little chilly. Perfect for a coffee snap, brunch pic, or just soaking in the vibe.

Where to take your shot: In the courtyard framed by autumn leaves — don't forget to look the part with a latte and one of their famous jaffles.

MAYNE STREET, GULGONG: Step back in time on historic Mayne Street, Gulgong — a streetscape so cinematic it's practically a movie set (and yes, it actually has been!). Heritage buildings, charming facades, and wide, tree-lined streets make this town a treasure trove of Instagrammable corners.

Where to take your shot: Wander along the street late afternoon for golden light, framing the heritage façades, vintage shopfronts, and maybe even the Prince of Wales Hotel or Holtermann Museum. Bonus points for a dramatic selfie like you've stepped onto a movie set.



Our pubs are places where locals say g'day to the friendly bar staff each week. Where the meat tray raffle and the joker draw are must-attend events. Where seriously good wine lists mix with the roast of the day, for a pub that's a perfect blend of old and new.

Here's our picks of the region's pubs — we'll meet you at the bar...

THE PRINCE OF WALES HOTEL GULGONG

Quaint, quirky and quick with a hello — it's easy to love the Prince of Wales Hotel in Gulgong. Expect next-level pub food, good vibes and country hospitality at its finest.

GOLD & FLEECE HOTEL WINDEYER

A quintessential country pub with all the trimmings. History-packed bar? Check. Locals and visitors mingling over the pool table? Check. Live music nights that turn into crowd karaoke? Check. Pull up for a beer, then wander out back and try your luck — gold panning is still part of the Windeyer story. This Windeyer icon is a must-visit.

COOYAL HOTEL

A little off the beaten track, but definitely worth the drive. Snag a seat on the deck and enjoy the rural views, or head out the back where the kids can explore and you can drink your wine in peace! We love the food here — the kids' menu is home to dishes like "I don't care" (nuggets and chips) and "whatever" (beef sausage and chips). LOL. Try the chef's selection with wine pairing suggestions, or just grab a beer and take it all in.



LUE HOTEL

This regional icon has been serving great tap beer for over 120 years — and it shows, in the very best way. Add classic pub fare and the charm of this picturesque village, and you've got a winning country pub. Pull up a stool at the bar or claim a spot on the front verandah to watch the sun dip behind the hills.

KANDOS HOTEL

Located in the town's oldest commercial building, this century-old gem is truly the heart of the town. With new owners and a revamp, its newly renovated kitchen is home to pub food packed with local produce, while the event line-up features pool comps, trivia nights, live music and raffles.

THE GLOBE HOTEL RYLSTONE

Located in the heart of Rylstone, the Globe is the perfect place for a pit stop. Soak in the sunshine with a beer out the front, or settle in front of the fire with a glass of local red. You'll find plenty of locals to chat with too — and a delicious menu to sample.

PARAGON HOTEL



There's not quite a pub on every corner, but there's more than enough to keep you entertained. Expect hearty feeds, sport on the big screen and live local music that celebrates the weekend. Bring the family — there's something for everyone.

You've got full permission to indulge here — and if the waistband feels a little snug, that's the sign of a trip well-enjoyed.

Step into a region rich with stories. These are the traditional lands of the **Wiradjuri people**, whose connection to Country runs deep in the surrounding landscape.



Okay, so we've all heard of Van Gogh, Picasso and Monet. The big names in the international art world — the GOATs, if you will.

But what about the Mudgee Region creatives who are making their mark on the Australian art scene?

From potters to painters and everything in between, the Mudgee Region packs a punch when it comes to seriously talented artists.

Here's just a few of the region's creatives you need to know about.

DES HOWARD

The man behind Lue Pottery — a hidden creative gem. Des works with all locally sourced materials and makes his own clays and glazes. Add a visit to Lue Pottery on Harpur Road in Lue to your next Mudgee Region itinerary.

SAM PAINE

A creative triple threat, Sam is an artist, performer and writer. His work pops up everywhere — on walls, book covers and calendars, while his sketches have become some of the region's most iconic

brands (Robert Stein's farm series wine bottles included!) Head to Gulgong to see the now-famous Loaded Dog mural.

MICHAEL BOURKE

If you're a Mudgee local, you know Michael's work. It's adorned everything from beer cans to shed walls. His tongue-in-cheek creations are highly coveted for their playful take on the region — think Mudgee Town Hall as a Big Mac (yes, really). Check out his cheeky cricket mural on Market Street.

A Hollywood talent lies among us! Alex trained as a blacksmith before heading to the US, where he created hand-forged armour and swords for Hollywood movies (so cool!). He now works from his Rylstone workshop, creating public art installations and outdoor sculptures.

Exhibiting since she was kicked out of art school (yes really!), this Kandos-based artist and textile designer is known for her still

lives and landscape photography. A regular exhibitor at Cementsa, Fleur's hand-painted linen has a cult following — and we totally get it.

An oil painter living and working on farm just outside Mudgee, Kim is known for her intricate still lifes, stunning portraits and inspiring landscapes. Her work is held in private collections and is regularly exhibited at Mudgee's Rosby Gallery. Kim also teaches one-day painting workshops, passing on her skills to budding artists.

DENISE FAULKNER

With a degree in fine arts and a passion for watercolour, Denise swapped city life for a bush block in Mudgee, using birds, wildlife and the stars as inspiration. Her paintings have appeared in art shows across the country; check out Hello Possums! It's one of our favourites.

KERRI KERLEY

A woman who knows how to wield a brush. Kerri has created some stunning oil paintings that pay homage to the region — think scenes of The Drip and the Cudgegong River — and was recently part of Mudgee AIR, Mudgee's inaugural artist in residence program. Her wattle still lifes are hot property.

ALEISHA LONSDALE

A proud Wiradjuri woman, Aleisha brings a First Nations' lens to everything she creates. Her installations are thought-provoking, emotive and sensory — the kind of work that makes you want to reach out and touch it.

FELICITY CAVANOUGH

Felicity has a knack for turning wire into whimsical animals and sculptures — clever, quirky creations full of personality.

Through Art by You, she shares her love of creativity, running classes, often in cellar door settings, where wine is optional but encouraged.

AMBER HOOPER

Mudgee's go-to photographer, designer and graphic artist. She's snapped nearly every major business, event & attraction in the region, designed countless websites, logos, and posters — and she delivers every time. Last year, an exhibition of her photographic work sold out in record time, while her popular @themudgeeproject Instagram account is a celebration of what it's like to live, work & play in the Mudgee Region.

RACHEL MELCHERS

Inspired by everything from bushland to the coast, Rachel's colourful landscapes and joyful still lifes celebrate the Australian environment. Visit her light-filled Wandelen Studio + Gallery by appointment to see her work up close.

WHAT YOU'LL FIND: A family experience

Step back into gold rush history at Red Hill and try your hand at panning. It's a great experience for families, especially with younger kids, and you can even take home a bag of gems as a shiny souvenir.

Hargraves

WHAT YOU'LL FIND: Gold

Head for the shallow riverbeds of Louisa Creek (next to the bridge), swirl your pan and get the detector going — and see what you uncover. Gold pans and basic equipment can be hired locally — ask at the general store when you arrive.

Windeyer

WHAT YOU'LL FIND: Gold

Long Creek and Meroo Creek are popular fossicking spots, with access points behind the local hotel and along the creek banks. Gold pans are available for hire from the tourist park — perfect if you're keen to try your luck without bringing your own gear.

Sofala

WHAT YOU'LL FIND: Gold

Follow the Turon River and imagine the rush of early prospectors. It's a great spot for panning or metal detecting. Hire gear locally or join a guided fossicking tour if you want to dig a little deeper.

Hill End

WHAT YOU'LL FIND: Gold & Gems

Fossicking is prohibited within the historic town boundaries, but nearby Tambaroora Creek is legendary. You'll need a fossicking licence here, but the reward could be a glint of gold or a sparkling gem. Equipment is available from local stores, and guided tours run regularly for those keen to learn from the experts.

PRO TIP: for maps, tips and up-to-date fossicking rules, visit the local visitor information centre or check the Guide to Fossicking in NSW on the NSW Resources website before heading out.
