From adventure playgrounds, watering holes, farm animals and gold panning, Mudgee Region is the perfect place for the whole family this summer.

So, forget the beach these Christmas holidays — let's go bush...

What to do

CAMP UNDER THE (MUDGEE) STARS

Grab your tent and your mozzie coils and head to the Ganguddy-Dunns Swamp watering hole for camping, hiking and cultural tours through some of the nation's most important Aboriginal sites. Don't miss a chance to make a splash with John and Cindy from Southern Cross Kayaking — it's the most fun you can have above water!

STOCK UP ON FESTIVE FRUIT

Summer in Mudgee is cherry season, so slip, slop, slap and bucket (you'll need one for your haul!) and wander the cherry trees at 10's Estate and Roth Family Cherry Orchard to take home your share of the produce. We dare you not to sample straight from the trees!

TWO WHEELS ARE BETTER THAN FOUR

Cycle up a storm along Mudgee's popular Pump Track or go off-road to The Commons mountain bike trail — a locals' favourite that's a little off the beaten track...

GO ALL OUT WITH GOOREE PARK

Gooree Park blends kid-friendly farm activities with parent-friendly wine tastings. And those cheese platters are crowd-pleasers for every age! Book a farm tour and spend some time behind-the-scenes visiting Gooree Park's thoroughbreds and Waygu cattle, before heading inside for a private wine tasting in a very cool cellar door.

SOUP'S ON — AND IT'S ANYTHING BUT ORDINARY!

Cool off in style at the Icons of Pop Art: Warhol and Lichtenstein exhibition at Mudgee Arts Precinct. See Warhol's iconic Campbell's Soup II — Cheddar Cheese (1969),



sip something cold at the café and soak up world-class art in air-conditioned comfort. Big city culture, small region flavour — now that's pop perfection.

WORK HARD, PLAY HARD

Head to Gulgong and keep your (inner!) child busy on the flying fox, swings, slides, and sandpit at the Adventure Playground.

GOODBYE BIG SMOKE, HELLO BUSH

Lace up those walking shoes and soak up the great outdoors with a bushwalk at The Drip or Ferntree Gully rainforest. Check out Hands on Rock — a piece of the region's indigenous heritage - or cool down in the clear river water at The Drip.

TAKE HOME THE GOLD

Travel back in time via Gulgong to experience gold panning adventure and walk out a little richer (fingers crossed!).

SUMMER SPLASH

You'll be spoilt for choice when it's time to cool off, thanks to Gulgong, Kandos and Mudgee Pool. Play in the water park at Mudgee or tackle the water slide.

ALL ABOARD

The kids will be clambering to board the Mudgee Miniature Railway, offering rides behind steam, petrol and electric-powered miniature trains. And for just \$15 for unlimited train trips, it's an easy choo-choo choice.

LAKE IT EASY

If you're a fan of the water, both Burrendong Lake and Windamere Dam have all the hallmarks of a summer's day, featuring water sports, fishing, swimming, and wildlife spotting.

UP, UP AND AWAY

Beat the heat and get a jump on the day with a sunset hot air balloon tour with Balloon Aloft. Be sure to bring your camera, because the views — and the look on your kids' faces — will be priceless.



RIVERSIDE RENDEZVOUS

Grab your reel and cast out wide for carp in the Cudgegong River, or head to Putta Bucca Wetlands for a picnic and some twitching (aka bird watching!) action. Kids will love the playground and spotting the model animals along the way...

Althea by Zin is the region's take on a French patisserie, with croissants, mille-feuille, tarts and sausage rolls, plus a cute courtyard to feast on your flaky faves.

DINE UNDER THE VINES

Fuel up for the day in the vine-covered courtyard at Alby + Esthers. Snag a coveted seat in the cobblestone courtyard and treat yourself to a local cordial and their famous Esthers' jaffle.

SAY YUM TO YUM CHA


Visit the raved-about Rylstone dumpling house, 29 Nine 99, for a delicious day out.

WITH A MILLION STORIES.




GULGONG — A SLICE OF HISTORY WITH A BIG DOSE OF PERSONALITY.

Step into a town where history isn't hidden in museums but written into every crooked street and character-filled building. Born in the Gold Rush, Gulgong's narrow laneways set it apart from the wide streets of other country towns — making wandering here feel like stepping onto the set of a period film (which, fun fact, has actually happened).

Gulgong wears its past with pride. Many still remember it as the 'Ten Dollar Town,' made famous on Australia's old \$10 note, and the stories continue to come to life as you stroll the streets and museums. Step into the UNESCO-listed Holtermann Collection of photographs and see pioneering Australia captured through a lens. Feel the poetry of Henry Lawson woven into the landscape around you, and if you listen closely, you might just hear the lingering echoes of Dame Nellie Melba's encore in the oldest operating opera house in the Southern Hemisphere, right in the heart of Mayne Street.

Symbols carved into the streets hint at a secret travellers' language from another era, waiting for modern-day visitors to decode. And the town's boutiques, eclectic stores and rustic pubs turn shopping (and pub-hopping) into a treasure hunt all on its own.

But what really sets Gulgong apart is its community. Locals chat on the street, waves and smiles are exchanged freely, and the town's big heart is always on display. Jump in, have a chat, and soak up the warm welcome.



Rylstone slows you down in the best way — tree-lined streets, heritage cottages and a laid-back pace that feels instantly restorative. Here, the slow life is celebrated in cuisine, artistry and locally made treasures.

Meandering from one end of town to the other is almost meditative. The town's picturesque charm is a haven for the many artists and creatives who call Rylstone home. There is plenty to uncover within the town's cottage shops, galleries and cafes — from stylish decor and handcrafted wares, to treats for knitters and vintage music lovers.

Foodies will feel right at home here. From soulful cafés and friendly pubs, to some of the region's finest wines and produce, Rylstone is all about savouring the moment. Each November, the Rylstone Street Feast takes over the main street with long tables, gourmet flavours, live music and bustling stalls. It's a feast worth marking in your calendar.

For those drawn to nature, Rylstone is a gateway to enchanting trails and waterways. Ferntree Gully, Ganguddy-Dunns Swamp and Wollemi National Park all take centre stage here. Rare and endangered plants and wildlife abound, including the prehistoric Wollemi Pine — but its exact location is a closely guarded secret.

Rylstone's real charm is its people. Locals are friendly and there's always something happening. Browse the weekend market or enjoy a slow chat over coffee in the sun. Rylstone makes it easy to kick back, explore and feel right at home.

DIVE INTO NATURE


Paddle the waters at Ganduddy-Dunns Swamp — or up the magic with a guided full-moon kayak tour.

Kandos

AN URBAN LANDSCAPE ALIVE WITH ARTS, CULTURE AND A RICH INDUSTRIAL PAST.



ART, HISTORY, CULTURE OR SMALL-TOWN QUIRK — KANDOS HAS IT ALL.

Set against the bold backdrop of the aptly-named ‘Rocky’ and ‘Baldy’ in the Coomber Melon mountain range, Kandos is a small town with a big story. A community cemented (literally) in industrial history, now reinventing itself through creativity and culture.

Once proudly ‘the town that built Sydney,’ Kandos rolled with the changes when the cement works closed in 2011. Today, the biennial Cementa festival anchors Kandos’ transformation — a celebration of contemporary art that fills the town with curiosity, conversation and just the right dose of creative mischief. From almost anywhere in town, you can still glimpse the abandoned cement works, standing as a reminder that big stories sometimes come in concrete form.

Step back in time at the Kandos Museum, where industrial machinery, memorabilia and tales of hard yakka tell the story of a town shaped by the 20th century. Then stroll down Kandos’ main street, Angus Avenue, where you’ll find quirky cafés, galleries and crafts (almost certainly stitched, painted or knitted with love by local nans). Thrill-seekers in thrift will be in heaven, with multiple op shops hiding unexpected treasures.

But there’s more than just the main ‘drag’ to uncover. On Australia Day weekend, Kandos to bursts life with mullets, stubbies and thongs as the town revs up for the annual Kandos Street Machine — think muscle V8s, burnt rubber and a family-friendly spectacle that’s all about noise, fun and good vibes.

Kandos is a place of deep cultural connection on Wiradjuri country. Explore spaces for learning and healing through indigenous art, storytelling, workshops and guided experiences. Visit Ganguddy, the traditional land of the Dabee people, to share an experience of connection to country that will stay with you long after you leave.

GET ARTY

Join in the creative fun of Kandos’ contemporary art scene.

A SUMMER THRIFT

Bag up plenty of gems and knick-knacks with Kandos’ boutiques and op-shops.

Mullet up and feel the heat at the Kandos Street Machine Festival — V8 engines, burnouts, and big summer energy.

Join a cultural experience with Dabee descendants. Exploring the traditional lands and waters of Ganguddy.

Grab your sunnies and join the locals for a round of golf, bowls or a cool off at the town pool.

MORE OF KANDOS

Hit the open road, take the scenic route and give yourself time to explore. The Mudgee Region isn't just one place — it's a collection of small towns and villages, each with their own character and charm. Step beyond the featured towns and you'll find quiet corners, perfect for a breather. Spots full of local colour and places where the welcome is as warm as the weather. Whether it's fresh air and solitude, or good times with the locals, every stop has something worth discovering.

CAPERTEE VALLEY

Australia's own "Grand Canyon". Second only in size to the world's grandest, but actually wider, this World Heritage-listed valley is all towering escarpments and wide-open skies. Stop at Pearson's Lookout for that hit of awe. Adventurers can hike, ride, birdwatch or even take to the skies by helicopter. Slow it down with camping under a blanket of stars, or retreat to one of the valley's stays surrounded by nature. The town of Capertee makes a handy pit stop — top up on food and fuel and keep an ear out for the call of the endangered Regent Honeyeater.

LUE

A village full of surprises: a pub, a historic train track, pottery, farm stays, olive oils and motocross tracks. Keep your eyes peeled — koalas have been known to sleep in the local treetops.


HARGRAVES

Hargraves is often referred to as the 'veteran' of the region's gold towns. Pop into the old general store to stock up on supplies and soak in a slice of village life. The surrounding countryside is dotted with fossicking hot spots, so grab some gear and try your luck in the creeks and gullies.

WINDEYER

This village wears its gold rush history proudly, with reminders scattered through the landscape. The iconic local pub is the heart of the community — swing by for a hearty feed, a cold beer and a yarn with a local. Camping grounds and farm stays make it easy to linger longer, while fossicking opportunities abound for those who want to strike it rich.

Towns & Villages



ULAN

A good chance for coal truck and train spotting. Though, local knowledge says that if you slip some cash over the bar at the Ulan Pub, the beef jerky handed back is well worth the stop. Beyond town, stretch your legs along The Drip walking track — its shaded gorge is the ultimate summer cool-off — and don't miss Hands on Rock, where ancient Aboriginal art tells stories older than time.

SOFALA

A historic gold town, tucked alongside the Turon River, Sofala's hills were once dotted with countless gold rush camps. It's heritage main street still stands like a snapshot from the past — the historic town has actually transformed into an authentic set for several Australian films! A few free camping spots along the river make it ideal to linger a little longer.

BYLONG VALLEY

A pastoral valley of rolling hills and river bends — perfect for a scenic summer drive with the windows down. This sleepy valley rewards you with some of the region's most beautiful scenery. Once famous (or infamous!) in the region for its mouse races — ask a local if you're curious!

COOYAL

Cooyal's lively pub is a classic summer pit stop for a cold one and a great meal.


WOLLAR

Just down the road, Wollar marks the gateway to Goulburn River National Park. Pitch a tent at Big River or Spring Gully campgrounds or chase the breeze to the top of Castle Rock in Munghorn Gap Nature Reserve for views that make you feel on top of the world.

HILL END

Step back in time and wander through a town that once pulsed with gold rush fever. In the late 1800s, Hill End boasted twenty-eight pubs and more than 8,000 people. Today, heritage buildings highlight its rich history. Explore an old mining tunnel, or try your own luck fossicking with locals. In the 1940's, Hill End was rediscovered by artists and quickly became a thriving artists' colony. It is still a beloved destination of artists today. Arrive via the scenic loop through Mudgee and Sofala, or for off-road adventure, tackle The Bridle Track from Bathurst.

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

But first, you need to find your home-away-from home for your Mudgee visit - and you'll find everything you need for a luxe stay at **The Clairfield**.



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
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10 ways to live like a local

Locals orientate everything in the CBD from the clock tower. Trying to find a cafe or shop on Market or Church Street? Give directions in relation to proximity from the clock tower. And if you get lost? Stand at the clock tower and shout for help.

9 ACT SURPRISED WHEN YOU SEE FARM ANIMALS IN TOWN

Yes, seriously. From a rabbit that roams the streets with its owner, to a local who travels via horse and buggy, you never know just where a farm animal will pop up.

CELLAR DOORS

With more than 35 cellar doors, the region's wine scene is anything but small. These are family-run spots, where passion is poured into every bottle. Most are just a swirl away from town — wander at your own pace, hop between towns or let someone else do the driving (you've got tasting to do).

This isn't mass production — it's wine made with heart, often poured by the same hands that made it.

Rich soils, varied elevations and four distinct seasons are the secret behind Mudgee Region's wide range of wine varieties and flavours.

BREWERIES & DISTILLERIES

The region is home to a crew of craft breweries and small-batch distillers — and they're doing things their own way. These makers aren't chasing large-scale production — they're all about flavour, creativity and keeping it local. Enjoy beers brewed with local ingredients and spirits infused with fruit from just down the road.

Small-batch means more care, more character and more room to experiment — so you'll often find something surprising on the menu.

Each spot has its own vibe and the kind of experience you won't find in the big city. Pull up a chair, have a drink and swap stories with the maker — it's all part of this small region with big charm.

Roth's Wine Bar + Cellar

OMG. IT'S FINALLY HAPPENING. THE GIRLS' WEEKEND MADE IT OUT OF THE GROUP CHAT.

Four women. One weekend away. A year of negotiations and calendar scheduling. Three failed attempts, thanks to a pregnancy, a child's broken leg, a chicken pox outbreak and an immovable work deadline.

But IT IS FINALLY HERE. And Mudgee is not going to know what hit it.

We've missed a lot of goss over the last year — Bee is considering an open relationship, Josie got a promotion and Lulu is back on the apps.

Ooft.

But while we catch up, let's start the long weekend right, with some boutique shopping — Rylstone-style.

Before we hit Mudgee proper, we're heading down Louee Street, trading sob stories while flicking through boxes of records at **Rylstone Retro Records**, tasting local date and almond chutney and to-die-for rocky road at **The Country Plate** and buying wool at **Convent and Chapel Wool Shop**.

We've already covered Lulu's latest failed Tinder date (ouch!) by the time we arrive in Mudgee, where fashion, food, and furnishings are the theme of the main streets.

We start with a visit to **Willow Collective** — and bye bye money.

Someone please hold us; we cannot get enough of the relaxed, stylish options, the seasonal colours, the natural fibres and the on-trend accessories. Because you're living the country life now, so you've got to dress the part. And with the store owner, Katy, recommending looks for everyone, we're leaving with full shopping bags — and even fuller suitcases.

We'll be drinking a lot of wine this weekend, so to keep things balanced, we're kicking off the festivities with a gin. **Baker Williams Distillery** is a cosy little family operation — the person who serves you at the counter has just been out the back peeling oranges for the Orancello, or crushing grapes for a deep red Shiraz gin. They know exactly how the liqueurs are made, what they should be paired with for #drinkgoals and cocktail recipes you'll make forever. We take home Butterscotch Schnapps for Bee's sweet tooth, a Coffee Liqueur for Emmy's serious caffeine addiction and a couple of classic gins because we're going to want



martinis tomorrow afternoon. Before we head out for the evening, we stop into **McKenna Terraces** — our home for the long weekend. A row of recently renovated heritage townhouses, these terraces are close enough to wander home, but just off the main drag for a good night's sleep. A gift hamper of Mudgee goodies awaits (YES PLEASE!) and with private parking in the back and a friendly country pub on the corner, you almost want to just settle in here for the weekend and not go out again. Almost.

The best spot to watch the sun set over the Mudgee valley is **First Ridge Wines**. Their cellar door is perched on a hill, with 360-degree rolling vineyard views. Now they're just showing off! Grab a table for the whole gang and prepare for a range of Italian wine varieties grown on-site. These are rich, full-bodied wines made for sumptuous meals and lively conversation. Drop everything the moment golden hour hits, and fly out to the verandah for a group selfie. Get the vines in the background. Get the sunset on the hills. It's bliss — one big table, Sangiovese flowing, the

women who know you best and make you laugh the most, finally all in one place.

Back to town, and we're pulling into **Roth's Wine Bar**, the longest-running wine bar in NSW. Rumour has it that the art work on the front windows was painted by the local nuns, so the children from the nearby Catholic School couldn't see into this den of sin. Oh, we're clutching our pearls just thinking about it! Dinner is wood-fired pizza served in the courtyard, and the tastiest sides in town — the duck spring rolls are *chef's kiss*. There's a local muso playing covers in the shed and he somehow knows everyone's favourite songs. We're up on the dance floor, the shoes are off and you know sh*t is about to get real. Arms in the air, singing along — you can see how Roth's has stayed open for a hundred years, no matter what the nuns say.



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
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A GOOD GLASS DESERVES GREAT FOOD — AND THE MUDGEE REGION DELIVERS.

You've got full permission to indulge here — and if the waistband feels a little snug, that's the sign of a trip well-enjoyed.

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
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
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

Start at the **Mudgee Arts Precinct**, where homegrown talent meets touring exhibitions. Wander the **Sculpture Walk** along the river, stretching into Gulgong, Kandos and Rylstone. Art pops up everywhere — in cafés, cellar doors and wineries — so inspiration is never far from your next sip.

The region celebrates creativity with festivals, exhibitions and galleries that turn towns and vineyards into living canvases. Get involved: meet the artists, join a workshop and spark your own creativity.

HISTORY & HERITAGE

Step into a region rich with stories. These are the traditional lands of the **Wiradjuri people**, whose connection to Country runs deep in the surrounding landscape.

Explore **Mudgee**, once the bustling hub for surrounding villages, where wild tales hide around every corner. **Kandos** tells of industry and reinvention; its cement works legacy now mingling with a thriving arts scene. **Rylstone** hums with the rhythms of country life and farming traditions, while **Gulgong** whisks you back to the gold rush with heritage streets, four fascinating museums, and the UNESCO-listed Holtermann Collection of pioneering photography.

The Art Trail

FOLLOW THE MUDGEES REGION ART TRAIL TO UNCOVER SOME HIDDEN ARTISTIC GEMS

They say art is in the eye of the beholder — and there's plenty of works to capture your attention throughout the Mudgee Region.

No need to know your Picassos from your Monets here — the Mudgee Region's art trail is designed to be appreciated and enjoyed by everyone.

Wander along the art trail to uncover some of the region's most beloved works and sculptures — feel free to pose for a snap with your favourite pieces!

JACK THOMPSON — a kangaroo statue that's not what it seems! Based on the famous Cleo centrefold of Aussie actor Jack Thompson, this kangaroo takes relaxation, flex and bravado to a whole new level.

LOUISA LAWSON STATUE — the town's first female statue #girlpower. Created by Mudgee sculptor Margot Stephens, the statue pays homage to Louisa Lawson — mother of poet Henry Lawson and renowned advocate for women's rights. Have a look under Louisa's skirt (we're blushing already!) for a little Easter egg left by the sculptor...

CUBE STACK — a stack of blocks poised dangerously. No need to panic — this work isn't going anywhere.

HANDS ON ROCK — Indigenous art with serious history. These stencils of hands were made by the Wiradjuri people — the traditional owners of the land where the Mudgee Region is located. Drive just past the entrance to the Drip Walk to get up close to some of Australia's rich Aboriginal history.


MURAL OF HENRY LAWSON'S THE LOADED DOG — created by local artist Sam Paine, this mural captures all the chaos, charm and character of one of Australia's most iconic tales — dare you not to take a selfie?



WAYOUT ART SPACE — a Kandos must-do. Home to a range of diverse and experimental collections that celebrate urban, regional, interstate and First Nations' artists.



WHAT YOU'LL FIND: A family experience

Step back into gold rush history at Red Hill and try your hand at panning. It's a great experience for families, especially with younger kids, and you can even take home a bag of gems as a shiny souvenir.

Hargraves

WHAT YOU'LL FIND: Gold

Head for the shallow riverbeds of Louisa Creek (next to the bridge), swirl your pan and get the detector going — and see what you uncover. Gold pans and basic equipment can be hired locally — ask at the general store when you arrive.

Windeyer

WHAT YOU'LL FIND: Gold

Long Creek and Meroo Creek are popular fossicking spots, with access points behind the local hotel and along the creek banks. Gold pans are available for hire from the tourist park — perfect if you're keen to try your luck without bringing your own gear.

Sofala

WHAT YOU'LL FIND: Gold

Follow the Turon River and imagine the rush of early prospectors. It's a great spot for panning or metal detecting. Hire gear locally or join a guided fossicking tour if you want to dig a little deeper.

Hill End

WHAT YOU'LL FIND: Gold & Gems

Fossicking is prohibited within the historic town boundaries, but nearby Tambaroora Creek is legendary. You'll need a fossicking licence here, but the reward could be a glint of gold or a sparkling gem. Equipment is available from local stores, and guided tours run regularly for those keen to learn from the experts.

PRO TIP: for maps, tips and up-to-date fossicking rules, visit the local visitor information centre or check the Guide to Fossicking in NSW on the NSW Resources website before heading out.



You've spent your life hurrying to fit everything in, meeting every deadline, hitting every milestone. Between ever-filling baskets of washing, weekend sport that never seems to end (surely cricket doesn't **really** go for eight hours!?), minding grandkids, minding big kids (well, it feels like it sometimes), you haven't had a moment to just **be.**

Halfway through the drive to the

Mudgee Region, as the scenery opens to green fields and the traffic disappears, you realise: we don't need to do that any more.

Because this is officially your time. Time just for the two of you. No work to get back to, no mandatory check-list of kid-friendly sights to see and activities to race through, no children to entertain (they have kids of their own to entertain now — see how they like it!)

This Mudgee Region getaway is about indulging in quality experiences — whatever that looks like for you.

Let's start with accommodation.

So you want a classic country stay, right in the middle of town? **The Winning Post Motor Inn** is just about as close as you can get to the heart of Mudgee, without actually sleeping under the clock tower. With a pool on-site and a



classic red brick building has been divided into apartments furnished with a Berlin influence. The heritage features still show through in the high-ceilinged hallways and broad balconies made for relaxation. Yes please.

For dinner, make your way (slowly!) to the **Oriental Hotel** — a country pub that sets its standards high. Dig into a rich, rare steak matched with a Mudgee red, or pair a local chardonnay with a chicken parmigiana. The wineries are Mudgee Region's best-known drawcard, and one of the region's longest established vineyards is **Robert Stein Winery**. Fun fact: the Stein family were the first to successfully plant Riesling in Australia in 1838 (ooo, go Mudgee!) and Stein's crisp, dry, award-winning Riesling is still one of Mudgee's must-taste wines. Ditto for the Gewürztraminer — we can't get our mouth around the name, but the wine itself is a different story. Lush. Oh, and while you're there, check out the Motorcycle Museum for a range of classic bikes from the 1920s through to the 1970s.

cosy restaurant and bar, you can get *very* comfortable here. Cast your eyes outside— the shops and cafés of Mudgee are a short stroll in one direction, while the local tennis court is over the road in the other. Perfection.

If you're more of a "heritage charm meets contemporary chic" holiday maker? Book into one of the **Perry Street Hotel's** luxurious, stylish rooms. Located inside Mudgee's former Mechanics Institute, this

To pick up something Mudgee-made to take home, drop into **Mainly Mudgee Gifts** on the main street. Sue has the best of all things made in Mudgee — from chocolates and chilli, to soap and socks. Snap up a little piece of the Mudgee Region to carry with you until you come back again — which can't be too far off — didn't you check out the real estate listings while you were here? We'll see you very soon...
