# The Rise in Slow Travel

IT'S TRAVEL DONE WELL

**LET'S BE HONEST, WE'RE NOT VERY GOOD AT SLOWING DOWN ANYMORE, AND NOW MORE THAN EVER IT'S DIFFICULT TO TRULY SWITCH OFF.**

Even on holidays, we're still plugged in. There's always one more email to check, itineraries to manage, bookings to lock in, content to post and group chats that never seem to stop buzzing.

Time away rarely feels like time away. We're still on schedule, overcommitted and trying to cram too much into too little time when sometimes, what we really need is a BLOODY BREAK.

This is the season for slower mornings, longer lunches and weekends that don't need a packed itinerary to feel full. Stretch out your stay. Switch off. Do less.

Because here, the best moments aren't rushed.

They're long lunches that quietly become dinners. Cosy cellar doors and country pubs where one glass becomes two. Fireside reds, lazy mornings and nights under impossibly star-filled skies.

Maybe it's the fresh country air. Maybe it's the wine. Probably both. But somewhere between your second coffee, another winery stop and a "quick tasting" that steals your entire afternoon, it happens. The shoulders drop, the pace slows.

Winter in the Mudgee Region invites you to lean into that feeling.

Sleep in.  
Order dessert.  
Stay by the fire.  
Put your phone away.  
Book the extra night. You know you want to.

And when it comes to slowing down properly, where you stay matters. Check into a boutique stay in the heart of town at **The Cudgee at Mudgee**, settle into the open countryside of **Wandarra Homestead** (and after all that space and fresh air, head downstairs to the secret underground bar) or switch off completely at **Glenayr Farm** where wide skies and an outdoor tub do the rest. These are the kinds of stays that make you rethink your checkout time before you have even unpacked.

Then there's the food. Comforting, generous and best enjoyed without watching the clock.

Pull up a seat at **The Paragon Hotel** or **The Globe Hotel Rylstone** where long lunches drift into lazy afternoons. Settle in for elevated local dining at **zin food + wine house** or **29 Nine 99 Yum Cha & Tea House**, where every dish somehow encourages you to order "just one more thing".

And no Mudgee Region escape is complete without a little wine tasting. Winter is made for it. No rush. No pressure. Just time.

Spend an afternoon at **De Beaupaire Wines** or **Bunnamagoo Estate Wines**, discover the relaxed charm of **Rosby Wines & Gallery**, settle into the countryside surrounds of **10's Estate** or gather your crew for a tasting at **Clover Cellars**. The beauty of wine tasting in the Mudgee Region is nobody's in a hurry, and after the second stop, you probably won't be either.

Of course, slowing down here is not only about wine and long lunches. It's wandering through local shops without checking the time. Picking up something beautiful at **Byrnes Jewellers**, browsing Whatever Mudgee or spending far longer than expected inside **Convent and Chapel Wool Shop** for wool, yarns and knitting products that have people flocking from near and far.

It is discovering the producers that make the region what it is. Handmade chocolate from **Spencer Cocoa**. Award winning olives and oils from **Rylstone Olive Press**. Cheese tastings at **High Valley Cheese Co.**

Bring the girls and settle in for a long weekend of wine, food and overdue conversations. Escape with your partner and swap routine for cosy stays and uninterrupted time together. Pack up the family and trade screens, schedules and after-school chaos for open space, fresh air and slower days.

Whatever unwinding looks like for you, winter is when the Mudgee Region does it best. Crackling fires. Comfort food. Delicious local reds. Accommodation so cosy you will start talking about extending your stay about three minutes after arrival.

Because sometimes the best holidays are not the ones where you do the most. They are the ones where you stop trying to fill every second.

## GULGONG — A SLICE OF HISTORY WITH A BIG DOSE OF PERSONALITY.

Step into a town where history isn't hidden in museums but written into every crooked street and character-filled building. Born in the Gold Rush, Gulgong's narrow laneways set it apart from the wide streets of other country towns — making wandering here feel like stepping onto the set of a period film (which, fun fact, has actually happened).

Gulgong wears its past with pride. Many still remember it as the 'Ten Dollar Town,' made famous on Australia's old \$10 note, and the stories continue to come to life as you stroll the streets and museums. Step into the UNESCO-listed Holtermann Collection of photographs and see pioneering Australia captured through a lens. Feel the poetry of Henry Lawson woven into the landscape around you, and if you listen closely, you might just hear the lingering echoes of Dame Nellie Melba's encore in the oldest operating opera house in the Southern Hemisphere, right in the heart of Mayne Street.

Symbols carved into the streets hint at a secret travellers' language from another era, waiting for modern-day visitors to decode. And the town's boutiques, eclectic stores and rustic pubs turn shopping (and pub-hopping) into a treasure hunt all on its own.

But what really sets Gulgong apart is its community. Locals chat on the street, waves and smiles are exchanged freely, and the town's big heart is always on display. Jump in, have a chat, and soak up the warm welcome.

# Rylstone

## SLOW DOWN AND SOAK IN THE CHARM AND NATURE ALL AROUND YOU.

Rylstone slows you down in the best way — tree-lined streets, heritage cottages and a laid-back pace that feels instantly restorative. Here, the slow life is celebrated in cuisine, artistry and locally made treasures.

Meandering from one end of town to the other is almost meditative. The town's picturesque charm is a haven for the many artists and creatives who call Rylstone home. There is plenty to uncover within the town's cottage shops, galleries and cafes — from stylish decor and handcrafted wares, to treats for knitters and vintage music lovers.

Foodies will feel right at home here. From soulful cafés and friendly pubs, to some of the region's finest wines and produce, Rylstone is all about savouring the moment. Each November, the Rylstone Street Feast takes over the main street with long tables, gourmet flavours, live music and bustling stalls. It's a feast worth marking in your calendar.

Rylstone still feels like a small farming village. Weekends mean community markets and showground activities, shopfronts alive with friendly local chatter. It's easy to explore at your own pace and just as easy to stay a while over lunch or a coffee.

For those drawn to nature, Rylstone is a gateway to enchanting trails and waterways. Ferntree Gully, Ganguddy-Dunns Swamp and Wollemi National Park all take centre stage here. Rare and endangered plants and wildlife abound, including the prehistoric Wollemi Pine — but its exact location is a closely guarded secret.

### DEWY WALKS

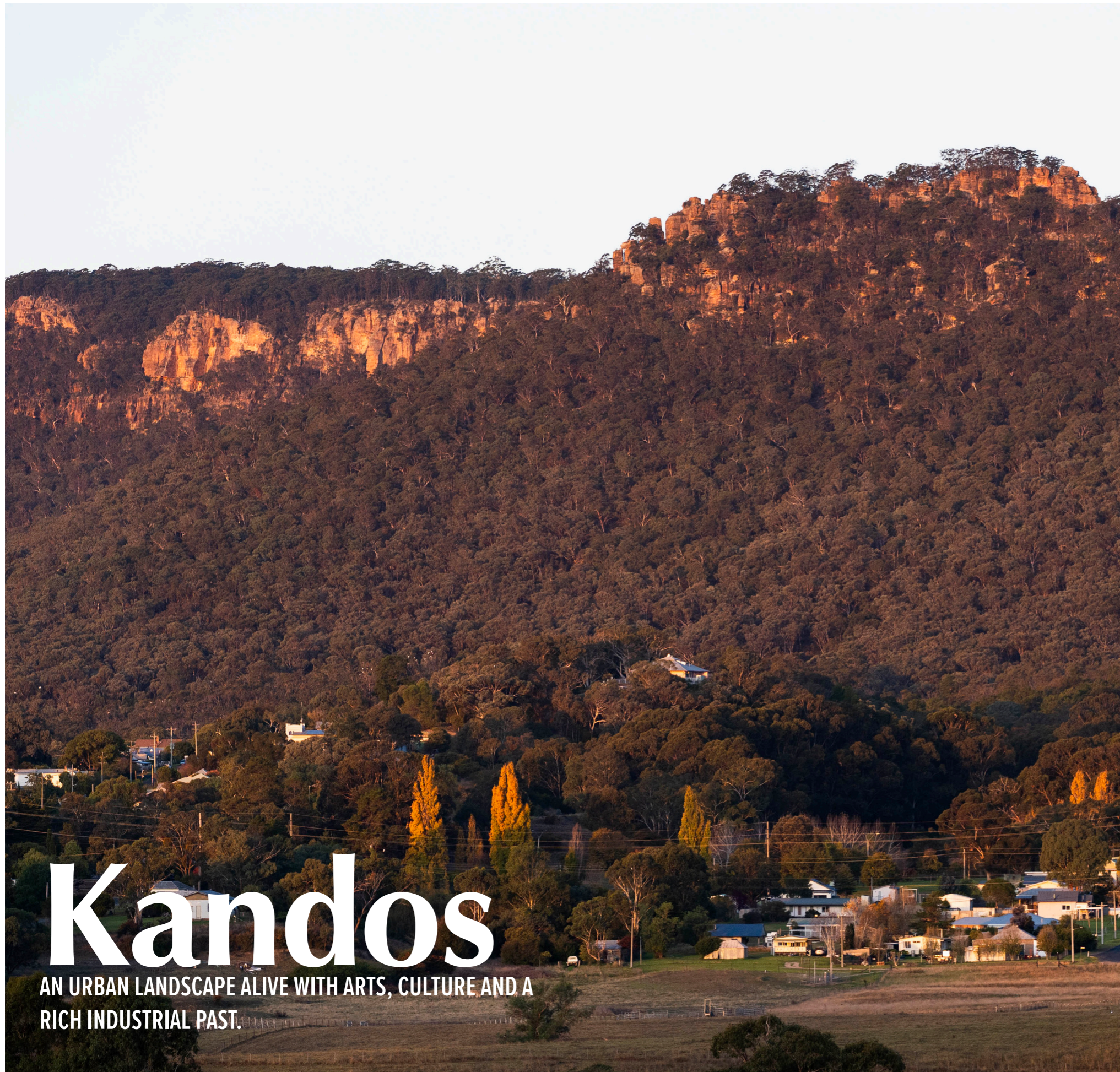
Morning walks become extra magical. Nature trails glistening in the mist and dew.

# Kandos

AN URBAN LANDSCAPE ALIVE WITH ARTS, CULTURE AND A RICH INDUSTRIAL PAST.

## ART, HISTORY, CULTURE OR SMALL-TOWN QUIRK — KANDOS HAS IT ALL.

Set against the bold backdrop of the aptly-named ‘Rocky’ and ‘Baldy’ in the Coomber Melon mountain range, Kandos is a small town with a big story. A community cemented (literally) in industrial history, now reinventing itself through creativity and culture.

Once proudly ‘the town that built Sydney,’ Kandos rolled with the changes when the cement works closed in 2011. Today, the biennial CEMENTA festival anchors Kandos’ transformation — a celebration of contemporary art that fills the town with curiosity, conversation and just the right dose of creative mischief. From almost anywhere in town, you can still glimpse the abandoned cement works, standing as a reminder that big stories sometimes come in concrete form.

Step back in time at the Kandos Museum, where industrial machinery, memorabilia and tales of hard yakka tell the story of a town shaped by the 20th century. Then stroll down Kandos’ main street, Angus Avenue, where you’ll find quirky cafés, galleries and crafts (almost certainly stitched, painted or knitted with love by local nans). Thrill-seekers in thrift will be in heaven, with multiple op shops hiding unexpected treasures.

Kandos knows how to put on a good show and embraces all walks of life. CEMENTA returns this spring, your invite to join the town in full weird-and-wonderful self-expression. Or, if V8 muscle is calling, start working on that mullet now for the Kandos Street Machine next summer.

Kandos is a place of deep cultural connection on Wiradjuri country. Explore spaces for learning and healing through indigenous art, storytelling, workshops and guided experiences. Visit Ganguddy, the traditional land of the Dabee people, to share an experience of connection to country that will stay with you long after you leave.

Hit the open road, take the scenic route and give yourself time to explore. The Mudgee Region isn't just one place, it's a collection of small towns and villages each with its own character and charm. Step beyond the featured towns and you'll find quiet corners perfect for a breather, spots full of charm and places where the welcomes are warm. Whether it's fresh air and solitude or good times with the locals, every stop has something worth discovering.

Winter is here so expect to sight snow in hills and villages of our region. Some years just enough to throw a snowball, other times a full blanket of snow brings out anything you can use to toboggan.

## CAPERTEE VALLEY

Australia's own "Grand Canyon". Second only in size to the world's grandest, but actually wider, this World Heritage-listed valley is all towering escarpments and wide-open skies. Stop at Pearson's Lookout for that hit of awe. Adventurers can hike, ride, birdwatch or even take to the skies by helicopter. Slow it down with camping under a blanket of stars, or retreat to one of the valley's stays surrounded by nature. The town of Capertee makes a handy pit stop — top up on food and fuel and keep an ear out for the call of the endangered Regent Honeyeater.

## LUE

A village full of surprises: a pub, a historic train track, pottery, farm stays, olive oils and motocross tracks. Keep your eyes peeled — koalas have been known to sleep in the local treetops.

## HARGRAVES

Hargraves is often referred to as the 'veteran' of the region's gold towns. Pop into the old general store to stock up on supplies and soak in a slice of village life. The surrounding countryside is dotted with fossicking hot spots, so grab some gear and try your luck in the creeks and gullies.

## WINDEYER

This village wears its goldrush history proudly, with reminders scattered through the landscape. From the iconic local pub to the nursery and old hall, locals bring the place to life with frequent community events. Camping grounds and farm stays make it easy to linger longer, while fossicking opportunities abound for those who want to strike it rich.

## ULAN

A good chance for coal truck or train spotting. Though, local knowledge says that if you slip some cash over the bar at the Ulan Pub the beef jerky handed back in a ziplocked bag is well worth the stop. Beyond town, stretch your legs along The Drip Walking Track — when the weather is warm the creek entices you off the main track — and don't miss Hands on Rock, where ancient Aboriginal art tells stories older than time.

## SOFALA

A historic gold town, tucked alongside the Turon River, Sofala's hills were once dotted with countless gold rush camps. It's heritage main street still stands like a snapshot from the past — the historic town has actually transformed into an authentic set for several Australian films! A few free camping spots along the river make it ideal to linger a little longer.

## BYLONG VALLEY

A pastoral valley of rolling green hills and river bends, perfect for a scenic drive through the countryside. This sleepy valley rewards you with some of the region's most beautiful scenery. Once famous (or infamous) in the region for its mouse races... ask a local if you're curious!

## COOYAL

Cooyal's lively pub is a classic country stop for a cold one, hearty meals and a bit of local entertainment.

## WOLLAR

Just down the road, Wollar marks the gateway to Goulburn River National Park. Pitch a tent at Big River or Spring Gully campgrounds or chase the breeze to the top of Castle Rock in Munghorn Gap Nature Reserve for views that make you feel on top of the world.

## HILL END

Step back in time and wander through a town that once pulsed with gold rush fever. In the late 1800s, Hill End boasted twenty-eight pubs and more than 8,000 people. Today, heritage buildings highlight it's rich history. Explore an old mining tunnel, or try your own luck fossicking with locals. In the 1940's, Hill End was rediscovered by artists and quickly became a thriving artists' colony. It is still a beloved destination of artists today. Arrive via the scenic loop through Mudgee and Sofala, or for off-road adventure, tackle The Bridle Track from Bathurst.

So, where are we going to stay? The chat mood is country chic. Waking up in a big, broad bed and opening the curtains onto farm fields under a hilly horizon. Wait, was that a dream or just something you saw in *Country Style*? Either way, you're going to live your cottage core best life at **Wandarra Homestead**. Located up a country road just outside Lue village, get ready to sink into a different kind of getaway here. Comfort, elegance and country charm, surrounded by expansive mountain views and interiors you'll instantly be pinning on your vision board.

Oh, and did we mention the secret trapdoor? Grab the cocktail essentials and climb down the ladder into the cellar speakeasy. For the rest of the evening, you're pouring drinks at Lue's most exclusive underground bar, **Grandma's Tippy**.

The foodies are in charge of planning your next adventure, and you're kicking things off with oil tasting at **Rylstone Olive Press**. The team will walk you through the oil making process, from the olive grove through the press and into

bottles that are winning trophies in Paris, London and New York. You'll soak a bit of bread into fresh oil, pop it into your mouth, and oh man, the foodies have nailed this one. This is oil like you've never tasted, fresh off the farm.

A local lunch must-do is **29 Nine 99 Yum Cha & Tea House**. Na Lan is Rylstone's beloved dumpling chef, bringing a taste of Beijing to country Australia. Sit on the verandah and watch the town go by or settle into the courtyard under shady umbrellas. Order a set menu and let Na Lan and her team bring you a series of mouth-watering dumplings, your herbal tea of choice and a delicious dessert bun.

Now, who first suggested Rylstone? The shopper of the group. Typical. They always get it right. They're leading you to the **Convent and Chapel Wool Shop** for a unique shopping experience. Famous among knitters, the Wool Shop has an enormous range of specialist wools, from just across the river or shipped from the Shetland Islands. Whether you're a first timer or an experienced knitter, you're going to find the needles you need, along with patterns, buttons, books and more. Every colour of the rainbow is here in wools, most of it from tiny boutique wool dyers around Australia. And if you're getting a little chilly, you might even be able to pick up a beanie or a scarf. Next, it's the wine lovers' time to shine and they're taking you

to the other side of town to **De Beaurepaire Wines**. Rylstone's De Beaurepaire family is making French wine in country NSW. How? They found the one landscape in Australia that's a perfect match for the soil and climate of Burgundy in France. On this 200-hectare homestead, historic stables have been converted into comfortable tasting rooms. Sit outside under the trees, sip a sparkling rosé, and it's exactly like you're having that French wine tour after all.

All good country folk know the pub is the real centre of the community, and you're going to love the authentic country pub experience offered at the **Globe Hotel**. Settle in among the local characters to get a taste of the real Rylstone. If you time it right, there's darts nights, the local permaculture meet-up, markets on the green and live music in the front bar. The bistro serves an ever-changing menu, heavy on local produce, prepared entirely in-house. No wonder it's a favourite dinner spot for the locals!

So, the foodies are full. The wine lovers are going home with a dozen bottles. You've had your "lush country cottage stay" experience. And everyone is knitting. It's time to leave Rylstone, but it's safe to say Rylstone won't be leaving you for a very long time...



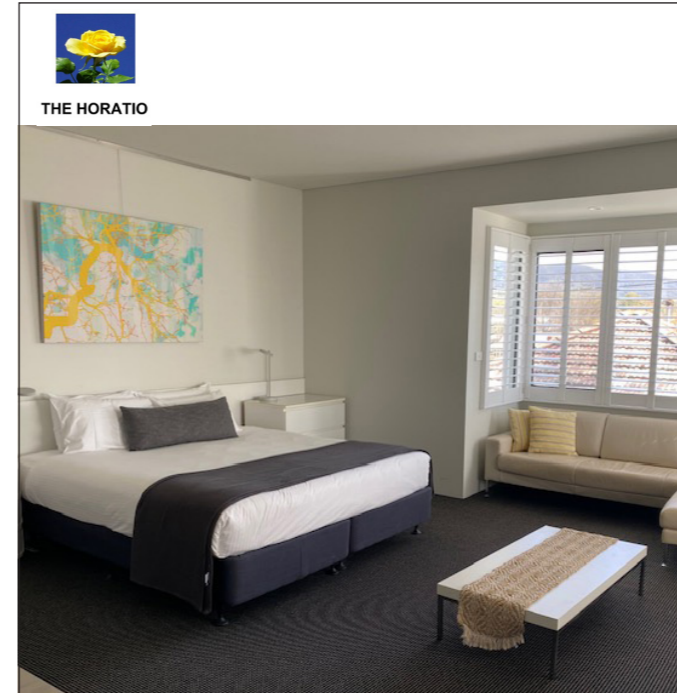
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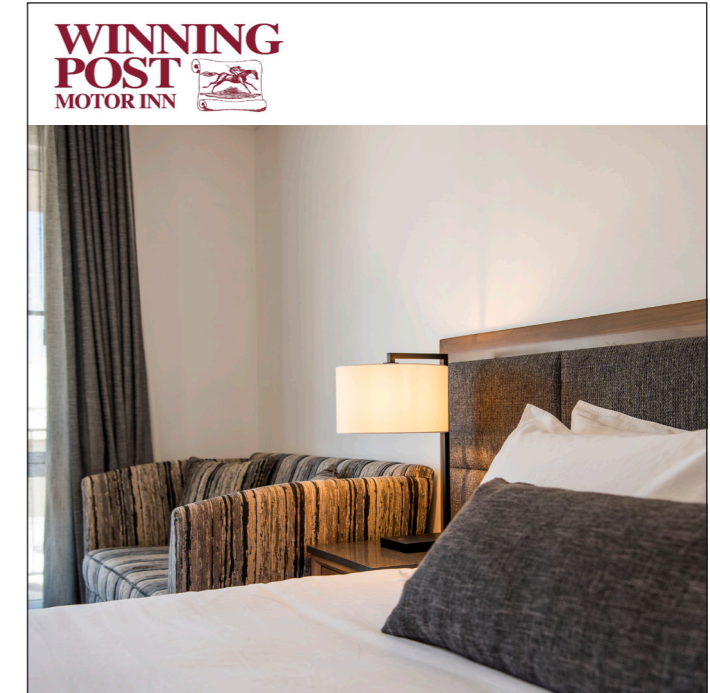

# 3 Days in Gulgong

A FAMILY GETAWAY

## THERE'S A MOMENT ON THE DRIVE TO GULGONG, SOMEWHERE PAST THE BLUE MOUNTAINS, WHERE EVERYTHING SHIFTS.

The road softens. The light stretches across the paddocks. And the kids, who've been bickering over snacks and playlists, suddenly go quiet.

You feel it before you notice it. Your shoulders drop. Your breath deepens. The city slips away in the rear-view mirror.

That's when you know you're nearly there.

Gulgong isn't trying to impress, and that's exactly its charm. Just outside Mudgee, this small historic town draws you in with warm

welcomes and a pace that feels... human again. No one's in a rush, and somehow, that gives you permission not to be either.

We eased into the weekend with a stop at **Gooree Park**. The kids clocked the open space instantly, while we lingered at the cellar door

set inside beautifully restored horse stables. A glass of wine, delicious dumplings from **Mally's Kitchen**, and suddenly no one was checking the time.

A family fav was the stud tour, hand-feeding carrots to the champion horses and wandering the paddocks. It set the tone quickly: slow down, lean in, stay a while.

By the time we checked into **Owl Head Lodge**, the shift was complete. The kids were off, full of energy and curiosity, on a mission to find the welcome-party "Gucci" the designer goat didn't disappoint, but "Archie" the Highland bull quietly stole the show.

Dinner that night was simple and perfect. Wagyu steaks on the barbie and local produce spread across the table (courtesy of our Gooree stop). Kids darting in and

out of the firelight, and a sky full of stars. We lingered longer than usual. No school night curfew here. The next morning came gently, with kookaburras and soft country light. Breakfast at **Beryl's Café** delivered good coffee, generous plates, and the kind of friendly, unhurried service that makes you feel like a local.

And then...we wandered.

That's the best way to do Gulgong, on foot, with no strict plan, just following what you find.

The town feels like stepping into another time, but not in a staged way. It's lived-in and full of stories. At the **Gulgong Pioneers Museum**, the kids could tinker and explore, getting a real sense of how things once worked - hands-on, a little quirky, and full of nostalgia for us.

From there, we meandered. The kids made a beeline for **Stacks Down Under** and emerged with colourful treasures and big grins. I snuck into **Wear It Outt** (because, priorities), while my partner happily browsed the second-hand stores.

The Henry Lawson street art added a playful splash of colour, an easy moment for a family selfie. A wander past the **Prince of Wales Opera House**, still operating and full of charm, was a quiet reminder of just how much history sits in these streets.

Lunch at the **Prince of Wales Hotel** felt like a given. Country pubs just get it right, easy, welcoming, no fuss. The kids refuelled and we continued to sit...just sit.

The afternoon unfolded in the same easy rhythm. The **Gulgong Holtermann Museum** drew us in with big images and even bigger stories. Then it was straight into the **Gulgong Gold Experience**, where the kids fully committed to their new "gold mining careers", panning and exploring the underground mine.

Dinner that night was at **The Vault**, woodfired pizzas, a few tapas to share, a solid local wine list, and gelato to finish. Relaxed enough for families, but still a treat for grown-ups.

By the final morning, everything had softened even further. No alarms, no urgency. Just a stop at **Cobb's Bakery** for coffee, milkshakes, and road trip pies, followed by outdoor play at the **Gulgong Adventure Playground** (hands down the best local tip).

Before heading home, we squeezed in one last must-do: **The Drip Walking Track**. An easy walk with a surprisingly beautiful payoff, water trickling down rock like nature's own curtain. Even the kids went quiet again.

And then, just like that, it was time to head back.

The car was quieter this time. Not just because everyone was tired, but because something had shifted.

I realised what makes Gulgong so perfect, especially as a mum. It's not about big attractions or packed itineraries. It's about ease. Space. Moments that don't feel rushed or overplanned.

It's where kids can roam a little freer, meals stretch out without pressure, and you might actually finish a glass of wine while it's still cold.

And somewhere along the way, without really noticing, you reset. You bring a bit of that slower pace home with you.

And honestly, that was be the best part...and the ice cream!



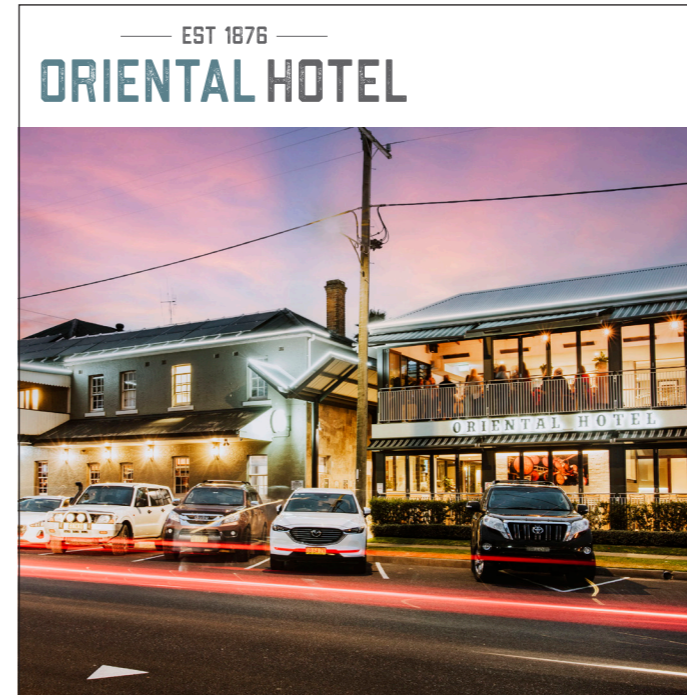

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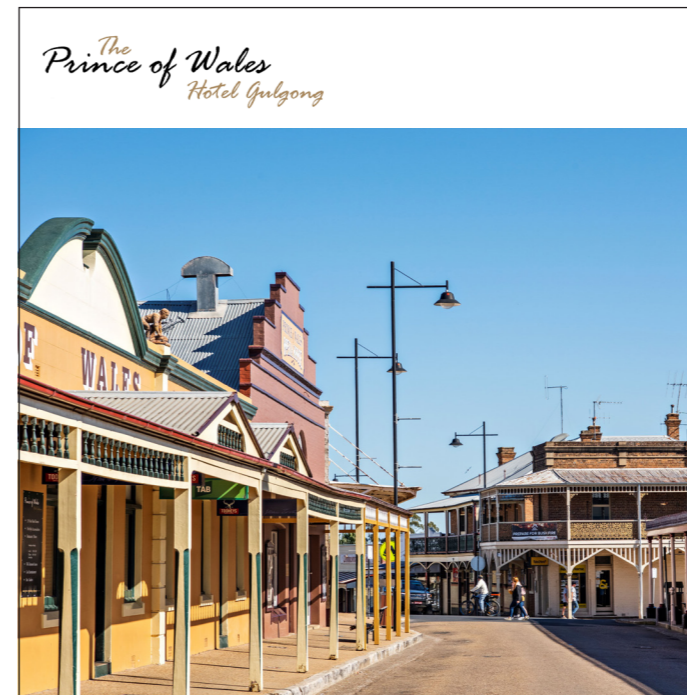

## ARTS & CREATIVITY

Creativity spills from every corner of the Mudgee Region. From local makers to renowned artists, discover galleries, riverside sculptures, bold installations and artisan treasures.

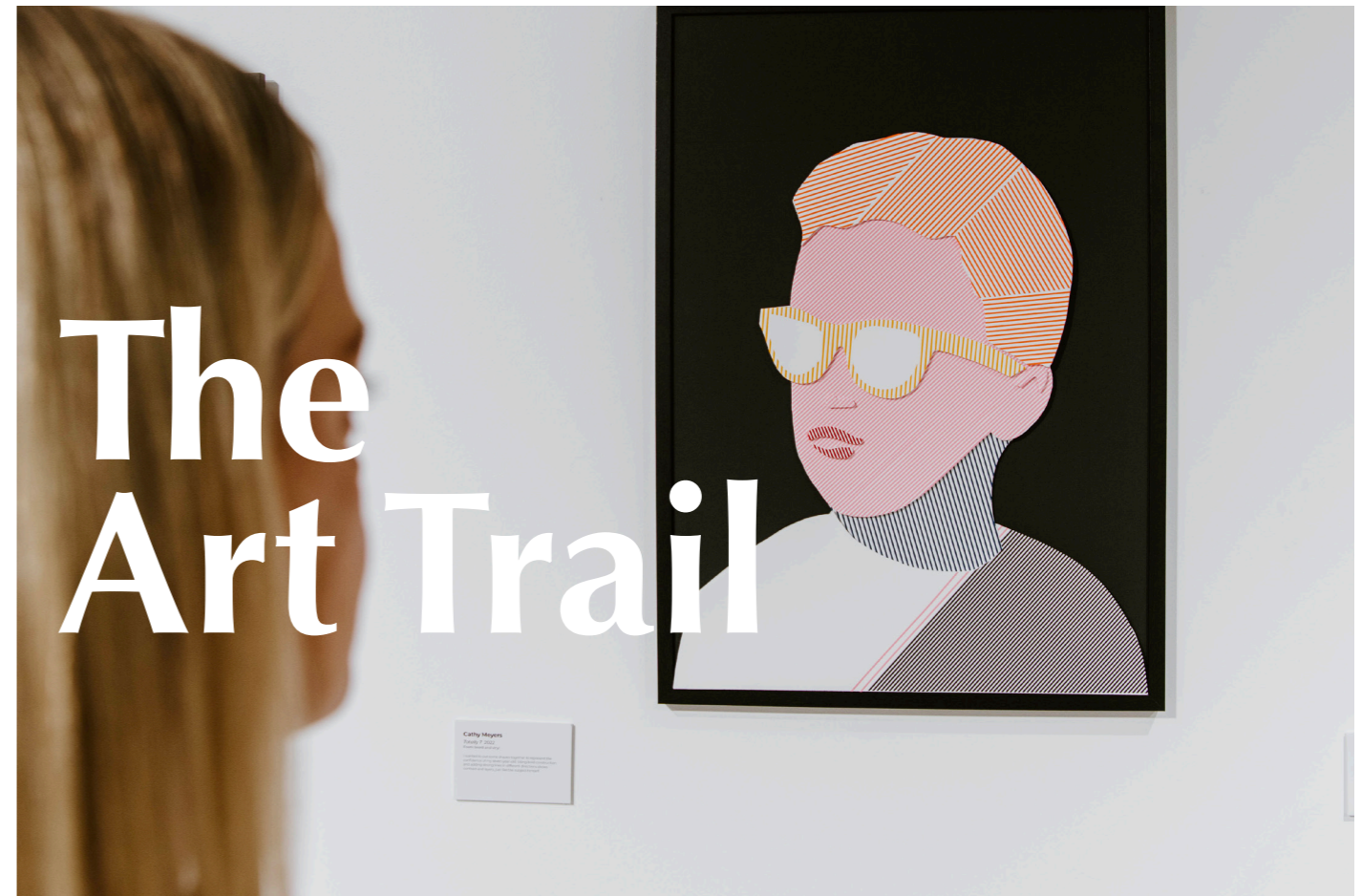
Start at the **Mudgee Arts Precinct** where homegrown talent meets touring exhibitions. Wander the **Sculpture Walk** along the river, stretching into Gulgong, Kandos and Rylstone. Art pops up everywhere, in cafes, cellar doors and wineries, so inspiration is never far from your next sip.

The region celebrates creativity with festivals, exhibitions and galleries that turn towns and vineyards into living canvases. Get involved: meet the artists, join a workshop and spark your own creativity.

## HISTORY & HERITAGE

Step into a region rich with stories. These are the traditional lands of the **Wiradjuri people**, whose connection to Country runs deep in the surrounding landscape.

Explore **Mudgee**, once the bustling hub for surrounding villages. **Kandos** tells of industry and reinvention, its cement works legacy now mingling with a thriving arts scene. **Rylstone** hums with the rhythms of country life and farming traditions, while **Gulgong** whisks you back to the gold rush with heritage streets, four fascinating museums, and the UNESCO-listed Holtermann Collection of pioneering photography. Here, history isn't behind glass — it's something you can walk through, touch, and feel.



## FOLLOW THE MUDGEE REGION ART TRAIL TO UNCOVER SOME HIDDEN ARTISTIC GEMS

They say art is in the eye of the beholder, and there's plenty of works to capture your attention throughout the Mudgee Region.

No need to know your Picassos from your Monets here. The Mudgee Region's art trail is designed to be appreciated and enjoyed by everyone.

Wander along the art trail to uncover some of the region's most beloved works and sculptures. Feel free to pose for a snap with your favourite pieces!

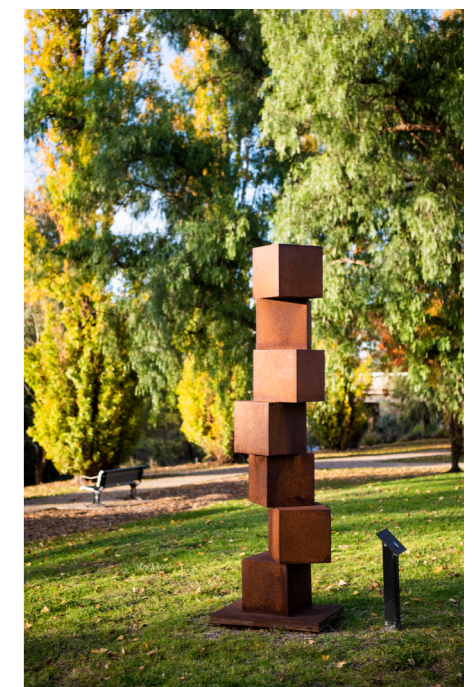
**JACK THOMPSON** — a kangaroo statue that's not what it seems! Based on the famous Cleo centrefold of Aussie actor Jack Thompson, this kangaroo takes relaxation, flex and bravado to a whole new level.

**LOUISA LAWSON STATUE** — the town's first female statue #girlpower. Created by Mudgee sculptor Margot Stephens, the statue pays homage to Louisa Lawson, mother of poet Henry Lawson and renowned advocate for women's rights. Have a look under Louisa's skirt (we're blushing already!) for a little Easter Egg left by the sculptor...

**CUBE STACK** — a stack of blocks poised dangerously. No need to panic, this work isn't going anywhere.

**HANDS ON ROCK** — Indigenous art with serious history. These stencils of hands were made by the Wiradjuri people, the traditional owners of the land where the Mudgee Region is located. Drive just past the entrance to the Drip Walk to get up close to some of Australia's rich Aboriginal history.

**MURAL OF HENRY LAWSON'S THE LOADED DOG** — created by local artist Sam Paine, this mural captures all the chaos, charm, and character of one of Australia's most iconic tales. Dare you not to take a selfie!



**WAYOUT ART SPACE** — a Kandos must-do. This regionally based, artist-run gallery is home to high-calibre, diverse and experimental visual arts exhibitions. Explore the gallery Thursday to Sunday and enjoy a coffee and cake from the newly opened café.

**MUDGEE ARTS PRECINCT** — Mudgee’s artistic home. Grab a coffee from the on-site cafe, wander through the latest exhibitions and keep an eye out for major international works set to grace the walls over the coming years. There’s always something for the kids to enjoy too!

Planning a future visit? Lock in a visit to **SCULPTURES IN THE GARDEN**, held every October. As NSW’s largest annual outdoor art exhibition, it’s always a showstopper!

From 17–20 September, **CEMENTA** returns to Kandos and surrounds, with over 30 artworks across town and the surrounding landscape. Expect the strange and beautiful, shaped by this unique corner of the world.

## Fossicking Trail

### Gulgong

**WHAT YOU'LL FIND:** A family experience

Step back into gold rush history at Red Hill and try your hand at panning. It's a great experience for families, especially with younger kids, and you can even take home a bag of gems as a shiny souvenir.

### Hargraves

**WHAT YOU'LL FIND:** Gold

Head for the shallow riverbeds of Louisa Creek (next to the bridge), swirl your pan and get the detector going — and see what you uncover. Gold pans and basic equipment can be hired locally — ask at the general store when you arrive.

### Windeyer

**WHAT YOU'LL FIND:** Gold

Long Creek and Meroo Creek are popular fossicking spots, with access points behind the local hotel and along the creek banks. Gold pans are available for hire from the tourist park — perfect if you're keen to try your luck without bringing your own gear.

### Sofala

**WHAT YOU'LL FIND:** Gold

Follow the Turon River and imagine the rush of early prospectors. It's a great spot for panning or metal detecting. Hire gear locally or join a guided fossicking tour if you want to dig a little deeper.

### Hill End

**WHAT YOU'LL FIND:** Gold & Gems

Fossicking is prohibited within the historic town boundaries, but nearby Tambaroora Creek is legendary. You'll need a fossicking licence here, but the reward could be a glint of gold or a sparkling gem. Equipment is available from local stores, and guided tours run regularly for those keen to learn from the experts.

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**PRO TIP:** for maps, tips and up-to-date fossicking rules, visit the local visitor information centre or check the Guide to Fossicking in NSW on the NSW Resources website before heading out.



# Get the Blood Pumping

THE WALKING TRACKS & BUSH WALKS JUST MADE FOR COLD WINTER MORNINGS

The best way to beat the cold? Warm up. Fast. Because when you live in the country, you've got two choices: hibernate for the cooler months, or rug up, get outside and get your blood pumping.

Morning walks just hit different here. The crisp winter air. The chill on your face as you hit the walking track. Your breath in the air as you start to pick up speed.

Whether you're after an easy riverside walk before your morning coffee, a wander down the (beaten) bush track, or a scenic nature loop, the Mudgee Region has something for every pair of walking shoes. Grab your beanie and your gloves and get ready to get warm up with these outdoor adventures.

## MUDGEERIVER WALK

- › An easy, flat, riverside path, surrounded by nature.
- › About one hour return.

Start your walk from the car park opposite the back of BIG W on Short Street and hit the paved track that runs alongside the Cudgegong River.

Say hello to the Jack Thompson kangaroo sculpture as you wind past the caravan park and towards Glen Willow Stadium. Head over the bridge and turn left towards Putta Bucca for a longer walk; or go straight on for a shorter circuit.

Stop at the dog park for a play with the pups if you've brought your pooch, or take the kids to the pump track for a bike and a scoot. When you're ready, follow the loop back to Mudgee's town centre and grab a coffee.

## THE DRIP WALKING TRACK

- › A bush walk set among the river gorge, with sandstone cliffs and rock pools.
- › About 1.5-2 hours return.

A bushwalk that's definitely worth the drive.

Located about 45 minutes from Mudgee CBD, the Drip feels like a mini-canyon experience - without the abseiling.

You'll be in awe of the stunning red-orange sandstone cliffs and the abundant plant life. See if you can spot the native apple gums, the tree violets and the rocky outcrops with orchids and moss.

After your walk, stop off at Hands on Rock, an important Aboriginal rock art site at Ulan.

## PUTTA BUCCA WETLAND

- › A peaceful circuit around a rehabilitated wetland.
- › About one hour return.

Switch off and take in the flora and fauna at this easy circuit walk. Located on an old quarry site just minutes from Mudgee's main streets, this wetland wander is packed with spaces to explore. Listen for the bird calls, look out for turtles, frogs and fish, and take in the peaceful surroundings. There's bird hides, relics of the former quarry and boardwalk sections to investigate along the way; the kids will love the playground and outdoor boardgames.



## FERN GULLY

- › A short rainforest-style loop through a deep sandstone gully.
- › About one hour return.

You'll feel totally immersed in nature here.

Known for its ferns, sandstone edges and cool microclimate, Fern Gully just feels greener and damper - like wandering into a rainforest. Boardwalk sections give way to more rugged rocky paths, where you'll feel teeny tiny amid towering cliffs, giant fig trees and mossy rocks.

Expect to see lyrebirds, cockatoos and the odd wallaby or echidna - and very few people.

## WOLLEMI NATIONAL PARK

This is walking for proper walkers. There is wilderness here and the terrain can often be a little, well, um, rocky.

Head to Ganguddy-Dunns Swamp for the most accessible bush walks; outside Ganguddy-Dunns Swamp, walks become much more serious. Definitely bring a packed lunch.

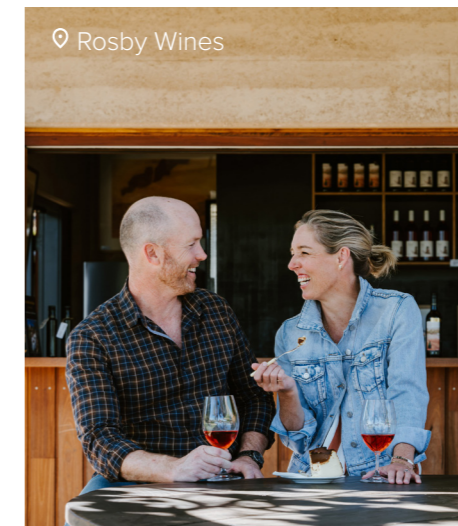

Winter wine in Mudgee is best served with a side of cellar door experience, and you'll find that winning combination at **Rosby Wines**, with its unique blend of winery and art gallery. Every October, the grounds of Rosby host a major outdoor sculpture exhibition, featuring artists from across Australia. For the rest of the year, this family-run vineyard serves some of Mudgee's most delicious wines, alongside impressive exhibitions of local and visiting artists. Sit in the stunning Rosby garden, surrounded by sculptures, and take your time with a bottle of wine and their famous burnt Basque cheesecake.

Just across the road is the bright and airy cellar door of **Bunnamagoo Estate Wines**. Get comfortable and let the knowledgeable Bunnamagoo team find a wine to suit your taste. Take a seat around a barrel outside or bring your own lunch and picnic

rug to set up on the green. The two of you, a bottle of red and nothing but the vines, the Mudgee hills and the birds. It's the perfect place for peace, quiet and connection. And wine.

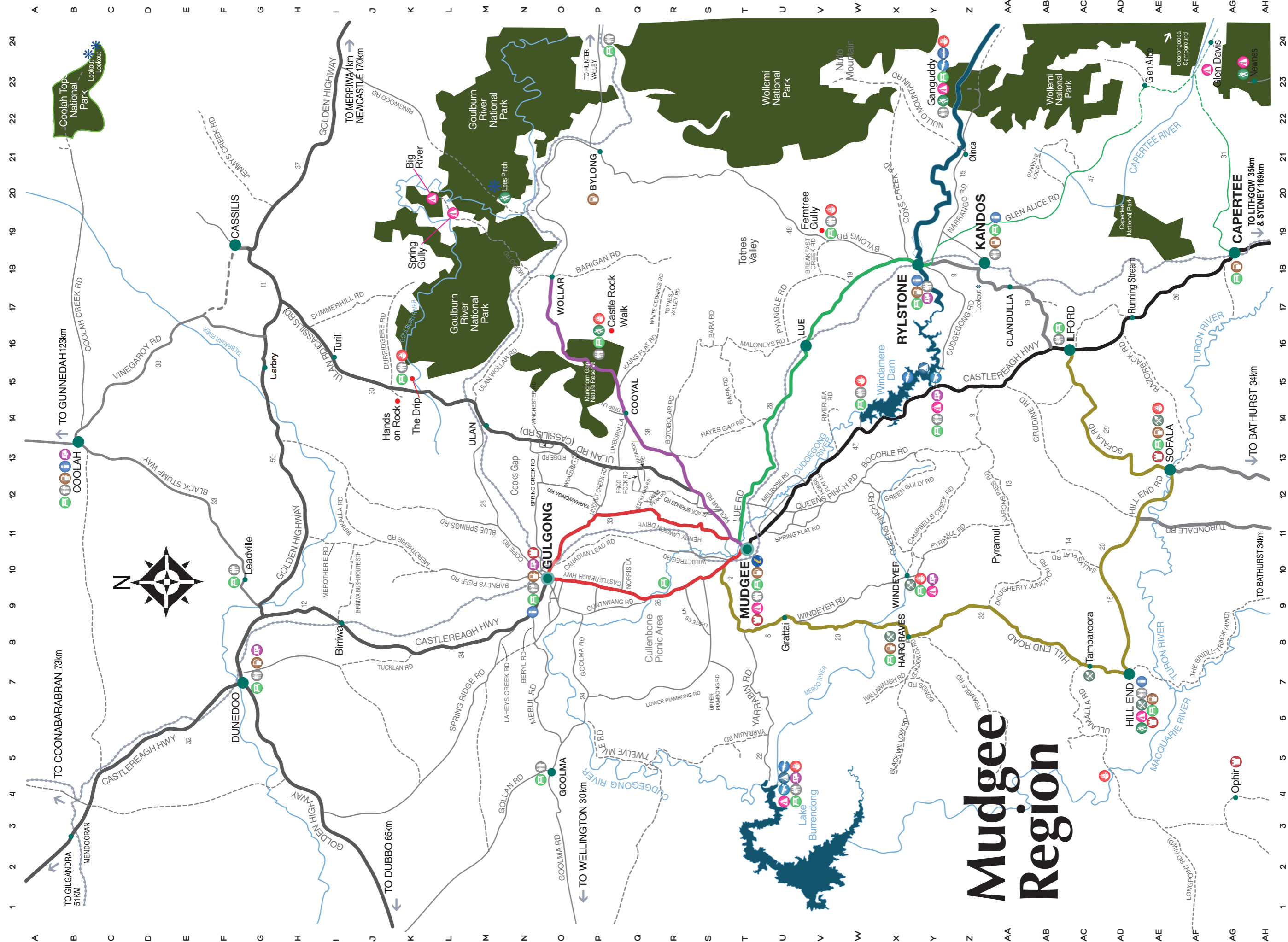

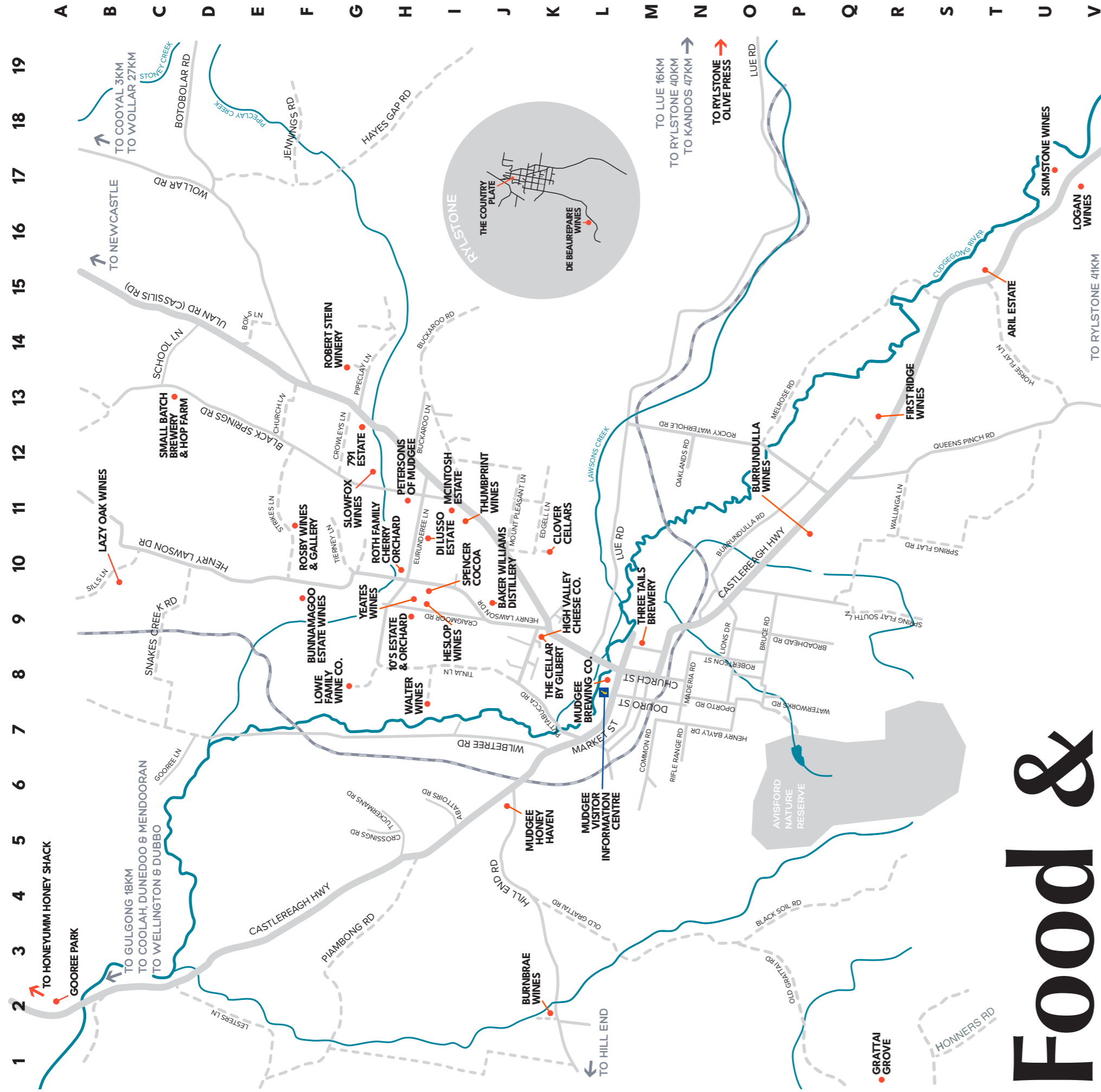
